A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS,
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION,
WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA,
TRANSPORTATION BASEYARD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5392, Bill No. 69, CD1, FD2 (2022), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2023 Budget", Appendix C – Capital Improvement Projects, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Transportation, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area by increasing the appropriation for the Transportation Baseyard by \$3,436,902, to read as follows:

"APPENDIX C - Capital Improvement Projects		
Capital improvement project funding may not be used for any purpose other than as described in this appendix. The total amount appropriated for a project may be used for the work phases provided in the project description. A budget amendment shall be requested if the total amount appropriated will be insufficient to complete all work phases set forth in the project description or if the project description does not clearly represent the work to be performed.

CBS-7244	a. Transportation Baseyard	[16,000,000] 19,436,902
	Land acquisition, planning, design, permitting, construction management, and construction of a bus and maintenance facility baseyard to include charging facilities for electric buses.	
	<i>3. West Maui Community Plan Area</i>	
CBS-7255	a. Parking Benefits District	1,545,000
	Design, planning, permitting, and construction for the installation of parking equipment and signage to manage access to County-owned parking facilities."	

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon approval.
