A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A
OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023,
HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED OR DERELICT
VEHICLES REVOLVING FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5392, Bill No. 69, CD1, FD2 (2022), "Fiscal Year 2023 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2023, is hereby amended as it pertains to Highway Beautification and Disposal of Abandoned or Derelict Vehicles Revolving Fund by changing the title to Highway Beautification, Abandoned Vehicle, and Tourism – Related Traffic Congestion Revolving Fund, to read as follows:

"II. SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023

- E. Highway Beautification [and Disposal of Abandoned or Derelict Vehicles] , Abandoned Vehicle, and Tourism Related Traffic Congestion Revolving Fund (Section 3.25.030, Maui County Code)
 - (1) Disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to \$127,388 and 2.0 equivalent personnel for the Environmental Protection and Sustainability Program.
 - (2) Up to \$1,366,935 must be for disbursement for operations or services for the Environmental Protection and Sustainability Program.
 - (3) Disbursement for equipment is limited to \$115,000.
 - (4) Up to \$10,000 must be for Teens On Call to maintain the Paia By-Pass.

- (5) Up to \$347,083 must be for disbursement for operations or services for the Highway Beautification Street Tree Trimming Program.
- (6) Up to \$50,000 must be for trash pick-up and removal of abandoned vehicles within the Hāmākualoa Open Space Preserve."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on January 1, 2023.
