ESTABLISHING THE DISASTER, RESILIENCE, INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS, PLANNING, AND LAND USE COMMITTEE (DRIPLU) OF THE COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS DUTIES, AND APPOINTING ITS MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Maui County Council's standing committees is to provide well-considered recommendations to the Council on legislation referred to the standing committees; and

WHEREAS, standing committees may also provide oversight of agencies of the County and receive information presentations on issues within the committees' subject-matter jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, establishes the powers, duties, functions, and declared policy of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Maui County General Plan establishes the following objectives:

- A. Protect the Natural Environment;
- B. Preserve Local Cultures and Traditions;
- C. Improve Education;
- D. Strengthen Social and Healthcare Services;
- E. Expand Housing Opportunities for Residents;
- F. Strengthen the Local Economy;
- G. Improve Parks and Public Facilities;
- H. Diversify Transportation Options;
- I. Improve Physical Infrastructure;
- J. Promote Sustainable Land Use and Growth Management;
- K. Strive for Good Governance; and
- L. Mitigate Climate Change and Work Toward Resilience; and

WHEREAS, the standing committees should be organized to help the Council further the powers, duties, functions, and declared policy of the County as established in the Charter and the objectives in the General Plan; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui that the Disaster, Resilience, International Affairs, Planning, and Land Use Committee (DRIPLU) standing committee of the Council is established for the 2023-2025 Council term.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui that, to expedite the business of the Council, the Disaster, Resilience, International Affairs, Planning, and Land Use Committee (DRIPLU) is formed to make recommendations to the Council on bills and resolutions and exercise legislative oversight on County government on the following:

1. Sea-level rise, shoreline erosion, managed retreat, deforestation, drought, wetlands, carbon emissions, pollution, and other related contributors to climate change.
2. Disaster preparedness and community resilience.
3. International affairs.
4. Comprehensive community plan updates.
5. Amendments of State land use district boundaries, the General Plan, community plans, and zoning designations.
6. Other land use entitlements requiring Council review and approval, such as Conditional Permits, and all overlay districts.
7. Land use ordinances.
8. Processing procedures for the General Plan and community plans.
9. Implementation of the Digital Mapping Project.
10. Oversight of the Maui Emergency Management Agency, the Department of Fire and Public Safety, Department of Police, and—in the context of disaster cleanup and shelter and emergency management—the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Department of Public Works.

11. Implementation of the following General Plan objectives:

- i. Mitigate Climate Change and Work Toward Resilience.
- ii. Promote Sustainable Land Use and Growth Management.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui that the following voting members are appointed to the Disaster, Resilience, International Affairs, Planning, and Land Use Committee (DRIPLU) of the Council:
