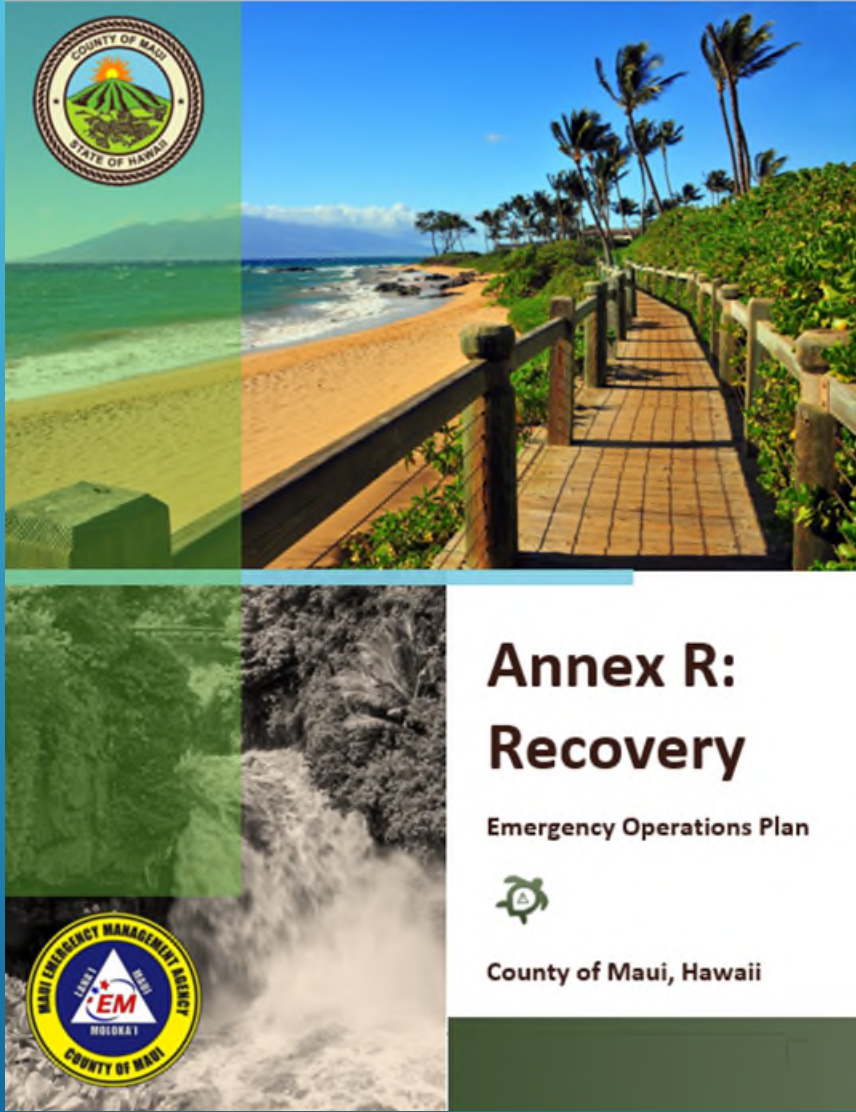

- Current
 - Promulgated Annex R: Recovery
 - Clarified roles and responsibilities
 - Phased roadmap of a whole-community response to, and recovery from emergencies and natural and/or human-caused disasters
- Future
 - Disaster Debris Action Plan
 - Working with DEM on revision
 - Clarify roles and responsibilities of key stakeholders
 - Emphasis on pre-impact and post-impact
 - Expeditious recovery to "new norm"
 - Distribution Management Plan
 - Multi-echelon plan outlining support from Federal, through State, and onto County
 - Move to revise current EOP to a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP)
 - One general reference that consolidates all County emergency action plans in the order of incident management mission areas
 - Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery

At 6:28 PM HST, radar indicated heavy rain over the slopes of Haleakala. Rain was falling at a rate of 1 to 2 inches per hour. Flash flooding is ongoing. The Monopou Stream and other streams remains elevated. Although rainfall has eased over other parts of Maui, runoff remains high.

Some locations that will experience flash flooding include Kahului, Kihei, Kiua, Kooki a, Pakalani, Makawao, Halimalie, Keanae, Huelo, Kipahulu, Haiku-Pauwela, Kaupo, Nahiku, Ulu-Palakua, Wailea, Pauwela, Paia, Makana, Pu'uene and Ma'alaea.

Stay away from streams, rivers, drainage ditches, and culverts, even if they are currently dry. Do not cross fast flowing or rising water in your vehicle, or on foot. Turn around, don't drown.

- Portable Radio, Flashlights, and Extra Batteries
- First Aid Kit
- Special Medications (Prescriptions and Others)
- 14 Day Supply of Non-Perishable Foods
- Manual Can Opener
- Hibachi with Charcoal and/or Camping Stove with Fuel
- Matches or Lighter
- Disposable Plates and Kitchen Utensils
- 14 Day Supply of Water - One Gallon Per Person, Per Day for Drinking and Cooking
- Extra Pet Food
- Store Water (Bathtub, Rubbish Containers, Washing Machines, etc.) for Hygiene

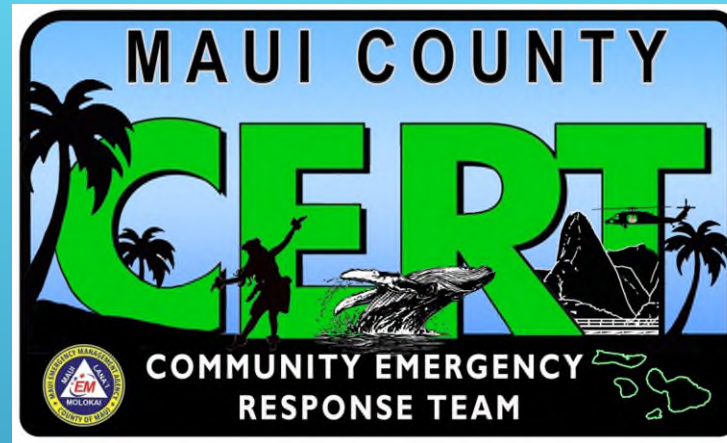
