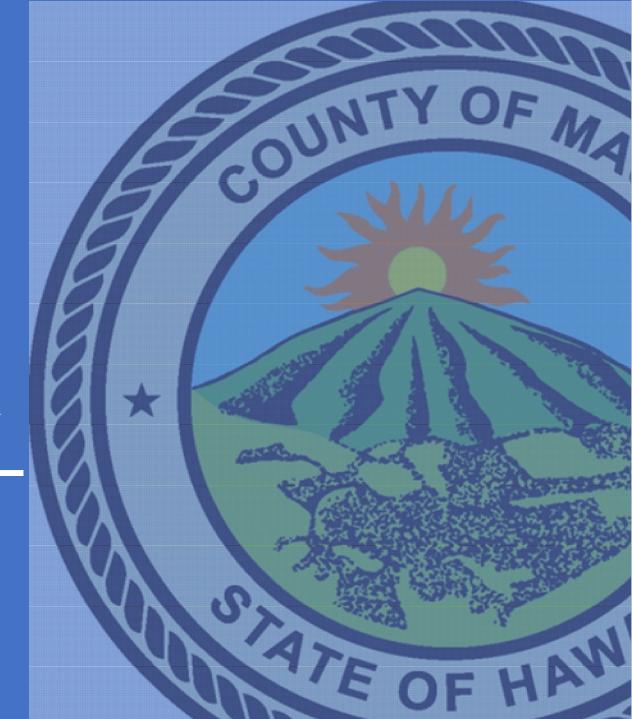

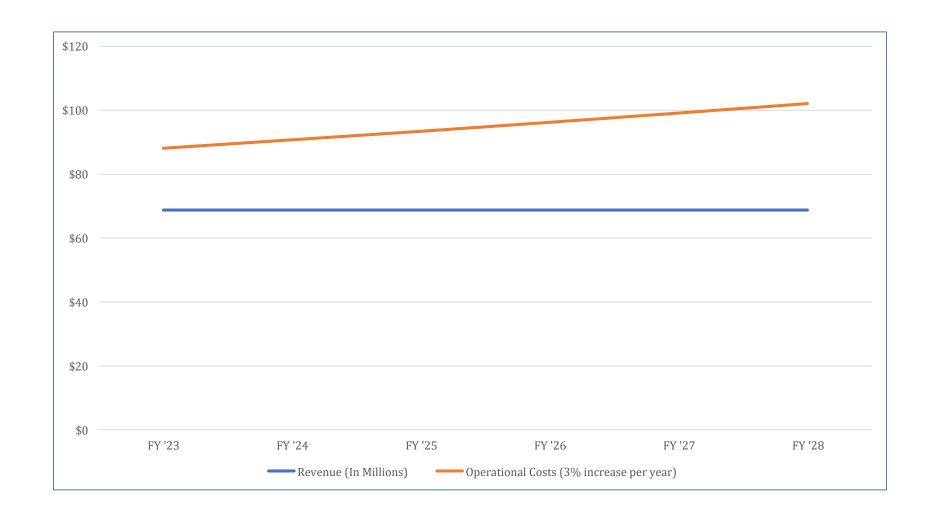

Water Supply Budget Deficit



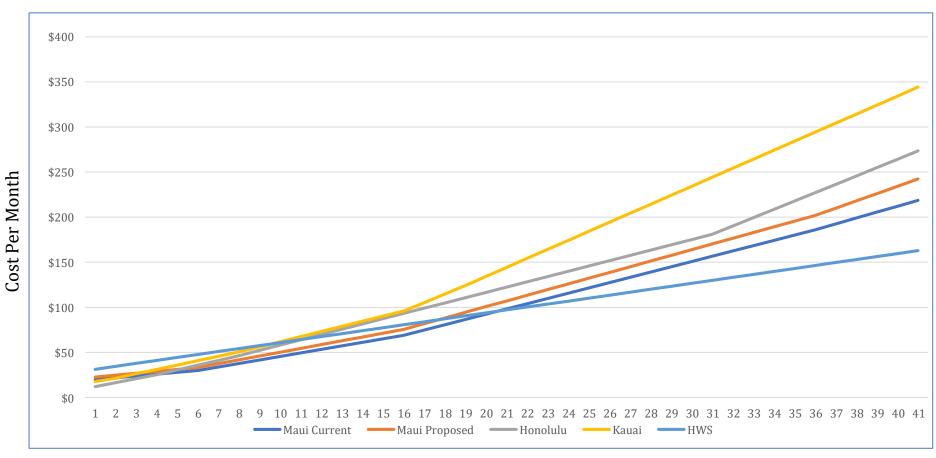
With Existing Fee Structure

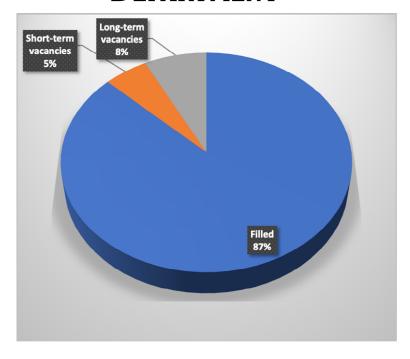

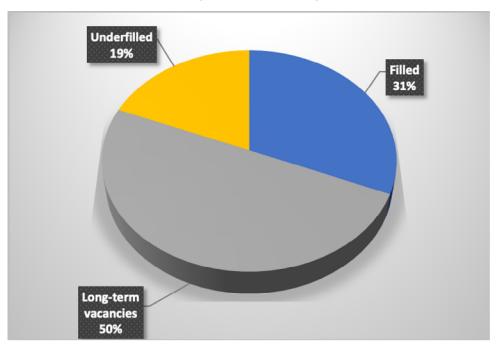
