

Office of the Mayor: What is different?

Overall, budget decreased \$12.5M

- Transfer of \$6.6M of Ag Grants from OED to Dept of Ag
- Decrease of (\$4.3M) provision of Open Space Land
- Deletion of one-time grant funding for Cesspool Pilot program (\$1.2M)

Additions

 Increase in salaries (\$631,471)

Added positions:

- 2 positions for EMWA
- 1 FTE Economic Development Specialist
- 1 FTE Grant Coordinator
- 1 FTE Innovation Officer
- Reallocation of an EA to Innovation & Sustainability
- TOTAL: \$363,176 additional budget provision for added positions


