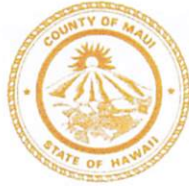


The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2023 Budget by adding a new grant entitled "State of Hawaii, Act 248, SLH 2022 – Kanaha Beach Park Graywater Reuse Project for \$1,250,000.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, COUNTYWIDE, COUNTYWIDE FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix C of the FY 2023 Budget by amending the project description to include the Kanaha Beach Park Graywater Reuse Project and increasing the appropriation by \$1,250,000. According to the Department of Water Supply, the Kanaha Beach Park Graywater Reuse Project is an important step to develop the County's first, above-ground, spray-irrigation system.
