

### **Overall Sentiment**









I am the sole owner of Lot 4 LCA 3386, in which MEO is claiming by quit claim deed that certain parcel containing 11.5 acres that is within Lot 4 LCA 3386, which was recorded in 1849 during the Mahele, there was no objection. Lunalilo's 85 59 B20 came into being during a land transaction from the trustees of Lunalilo to George Baker. This is how the appearance of Lunalilo is affixed to the maps of 1890. Lunalilo 85 59 B20 is on the north side of Waiehu stream also known as Lot 2 in Waiehu. The 1887 Map does NOT have LCA 85 59 B-20 on the map situated on the south side of Waiehu stream. The trustees at the time did transfer to Mr Birch in the north side of Waiehu stream before this misprint of the land was awarded to Pehuino LCA 3386 to Pehuino who held the same since the time of Kamehameha the first. It's a big land of 139.14 acres known in testimony as an ancient land, there is no dispute in parcel 4. Does MEO have any superior title than I have, then they should present the title to the council so they can make a decision and move forward or cease their claim to my property.
