A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.06A.080, MAUI  
COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FOR AGRICULTURAL WATER  
CONSUMERS FROM RESTRICTIONS OR MANDATES DURING  
WATER SHORTAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 14.06A.080, Maui County Code, is amended to read  
as follows:

**“14.06A.080 Agricultural consumers.** A. [In the event of] If  
there is a water shortage declaration, agricultural water consumers  
[shall] must be requested to reduce water consumption [to the extent  
practicable,] but [shall] must not be required to implement any  
restrictions or mandates imposed by section 14.06A.060 for the first  
[ninety] one hundred eighty days after publication in a newspaper  
of general circulation in the County.

B. After the [ninety] one hundred eighty days provided in  
subsection A, agricultural water consumers [shall] must be subject  
to the same provisions as other consumers.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is  
underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the  
brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.


