Chair and Members:

Your Policy and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee, having met on February 10, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 15-5, from Councilmember Mike White, relating to nominations to boards, committees, and commissions ("boards").

By correspondence dated and received January 28, 2016, the Mayor transmitted the following:

Your Committee notes general appointment procedures for the boards are outlined in Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), and Chapter 2.41, Maui County Code ("MCC").

The following general appointment procedures apply to the various boards for which the Mayor submitted nominations.

The Mayor is required to submit nominees 60 to 70 days before the prior members' terms expire, and the Council must approve or disapprove the nominees within 60 days thereafter. If the Council fails to approve or disapprove any of the Mayor's nominees within the time period provided, the nominee shall be deemed appointed to fill the vacancy upon its occurrence. If the Council disapproves a nominee, it shall immediately notify the Mayor of its action.

Accordingly, the Council has until March 28, 2016, to approve or disapprove the Mayor's nominees, or the nominees shall be deemed appointed.

Your Committee did not request to interview any of the nominees as part of its consideration of the following boards: Affirmative Action Advisory Council, Board of Ethics, Board of Variances and Appeals, Civil Service Commission, Council on Aging, Lanai Planning Commission, Liquor Control Adjudication Board, Liquor Control Commission, Maui County Cultural Resources Commission, Maui Planning Commission, Public Works Commission, and Salary Commission. Consideration of nominees to other boards was deferred by your Committee.

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A representative of the Mayor's office spoke to the merits of the nominees to these boards and assured your Committee of their availability to attend scheduled meetings.

Your Committee was satisfied with the nominees' applications and expressed its gratitude to the nominees for volunteering to serve the community.

Your Committee recommended the following 25 nominees be approved for the boards and terms for which they had been nominated: Barbara Potopowitz, Rachel Phillips, Allen Souza, Raymond Sung, Ralph Masuda, Linda Fujitani, Paul Wickman, Lois Prey, Helene Sato, Louise Corpuz, Walter O'Brien, Medigale Badillo, Zachary Helm, Gwen Ueoka, Brenda Lee, Nane Aluli, Whitney Apo, Stephen Castro, Lawrence Carnicelli, Flordeline Vila, Uvette Sakamoto, Harry Hecht, Brooks Aoki, Harold Ames, and Kelly Swanson.

Your Committee recommended that Exhibit "B" to the proposed resolutions be revised accordingly.

Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend approval of the nominations of Barbara Potopowitz to the Affirmative Action Advisory Council; and Rachel Phillips and Allen Souza to the Board of Ethics. Committee Chair Victorino, Vice-Chair Couch, and Committee members Baisa, Carroll, Crivello, and White voted "aye." Committee members Cochran, Guzman, and Hokama were excused.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend approval of the nominations of Raymond Sung and Ralph Masuda to the Board of Variances and Appeals; and Paul Wickman, Lois Prey, Helene Sato, Louise Corpuz, and Walter O'Brien to the Council on Aging. Committee Chair Victorino, Vice-Chair Couch, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, and White voted "aye." Committee members Guzman and Hokama were excused.

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Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend approval of the nomination of Linda Fujitani to the Civil Service Commission. Committee Chair Victorino, Vice-Chair Couch, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, and White voted "aye." Committee members Crivello, Guzman, and Hokama were excused.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend approval of the nomination of Medigale Badillo to the Lanai Planning Commission; Zachary Helm and Gwen Ueoka to the Liquor Control Adjudication Board; Whitney Apo to the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission; Stephen Castro and Lawrence Carnicelli to the Maui Planning Commission; and Harold Ames and Kelly Swanson to the Salary Commission. Committee Chair Victorino, Vice-Chair Couch, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Hokama, and White voted "aye." Committee member Guzman was excused.

Your Committee voted 7-1 to recommend approval of Brenda Lee and Nane Aluli to the Liquor Control Commission. Committee Chair Victorino and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Hokama, and White voted "aye." Vice-Chair Couch voted "no." Committee member Guzman was excused.

Your Committee voted 7-1 to recommend approval of Flordeline Vila and Uvette Sakamoto as members, and Harry Hecht and Brooks Aoki as alternates, to the Public Works Commission. Committee Chair Victorino, Vice-Chair Couch, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, and White voted "aye." Committee member Hokama voted "no." Committee member Guzman was excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed resolutions, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating your Committee's recommended revisions.
