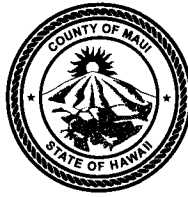

SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2017 BUDGET (FS-1) (BF-1)

Thank you for your correspondence regarding the request for more information relating to the fees, rates, assessments, and taxes for our Department. Here is the information that you requested.

1. Since Chapter 16.04C, Maui County Code, has been established and Chapter 16.04B, Maui County Code, has been repealed, please provide updated Maui County Code citations for the fees listed.

Fees for FY2017-2018:

3420 Fee for Inspections outside of regular business hours
Current fee is \$48.00 based on lowest paid employee at overtime rate, upon adoption of this budget schedule, the rate of pay for the lowest paid inspector will be \$34.75 per hour. At the overtime rate, the cost per hour would be \$52.13. It is suggested that a new fee at or above this rate be adopted. Reference for this fee is 16.04C.040 of Ordinance 4232.

2. Please also advise whether there are other fees authorized by Chapter 16.04C, Maui County Code, that are not contained in Appendix B, and provide a list of such fees, if any, along with the proposed amount of each fee.

These fees are not currently reflected in the Budget Ordinance. These fees are required for the following licenses per HRS 132D.

Fee for importers License associated with Fireworks (1.3g & 1.4g)
This fee is \$3,000.00 per HRS 132D-11

Fee for Storage License associated with Fireworks (1.3g & 1.4g)
This fee is \$2,000.00 per HRS 132D-11

Fee for Retail License associated with Fireworks (1.4g)
This fee is \$500.00 per HRS 132D-11

§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the purchase and use of:

- (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers upon payment of a fee of \$25;
- (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon payment of a fee of \$110; and
- (3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section 132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time other than during the periods prescribed in section 132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25. [L 1994, c 180, pt of §1; am L 2000, c 233, §10; am L 2006, c 183, §12; am L 2008, c 38, §3]

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§132D-11 Fee. (a) The fee for the license required under section 132D-7 shall be \$3,000 for importers, \$2,000 for each wholesaler's site, \$1,000 for each storage site, and \$500 for each retailer's site for each year or fraction of a year in which the licensee plans to conduct business and shall be payable to the county. The license fees shall be used solely by each county fire department to pay for the salary of an auditor of fireworks and articles pyrotechnic records and all expenses incurred to fulfill the duties required, including the inspection of inventory and storage facilities, maintenance of required records, and the training of the auditor. The auditor shall monitor strict inventory and recordkeeping requirements to ensure that sales of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic are made only to license or permit holders under this chapter. The county shall provide an exemption from the fees under this section to nonprofit community groups for importation and storage of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic for displays once a year.

(b) The fee for the license required under section 132D-7 shall be the fee specified in subsection (a) for each year, fraction of a year, or event in which the licensee plans to conduct business and shall be payable to the county in which the permitted activity is to occur. 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[§132D-16.6] **Display site inspection.** Each county fire chief is authorized to conduct inspections of the persons conducting a display, including the site where the display is occurring or will occur within the fire chief's county to determine compliance with the applicable county code and the current editions of the National Fire Protection Association's "NFPA 1123: Code for Fireworks Display" and "NFPA 1126: Standard for the Use of Pyrotechnics Before a Proximate Audience". An inspection fee of \$200 shall be assessed by the county upon the holder of a permit for a display under section 132D-10(2), which shall be separate from the display permit fee under that section. The inspection fee shall be paid to the county in which the display will occur, and shall be used to defray the cost of the official conducting the inspection of the display setup.
