

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION
AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED VEHICLES REVOLVING FUND AND THE
LITTER CONTROL REVOLVING FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the fund to which costs of litter control authorized by the Maui County Code are deposited. Rather than reference a litter control revolving fund which was never established, the costs will be deposited into the existing highway beautification fund. This ordinance will also amend the name of the highway beautification fund for consistency with Section 286-51(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes. Finally, the ordinance will remove "Community Work Day" because the organization has been renamed, and instead use a broader reference to highway beautification.

SECTION 2. Section 3.25.030, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection B to read as follows:

"B. The moneys so assessed and collected shall be placed in a revolving fund entitled, "the highway beautification and disposal of abandoned or derelict vehicles revolving fund," to be used and administered by the County for the purpose of beautification and other related activities, including, but not limited to, animal management program carcass removal and [Community Work Day] highway beautification, concerning highways under the ownership, control, and jurisdiction of the County, and to defray the additional cost in the disposition and other related activities of abandoned vehicles as prescribed in chapter 290, [HRS.] Hawaii Revised Statutes."

SECTION 3. Section 20.20.070, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection C to read as follows:

“C. All moneys collected under this section shall be deposited into the [litter control revolving fund as] highway beautification and disposal of abandoned or derelict vehicles revolving fund established [in] by section 3.25.030 of the Maui County Code.”


SECTION 4. Section 20.20.080, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“20.20.080 The highway beautification and disposal of abandoned or derelict vehicles revolving fund. All costs recovered and other funds collected or received pursuant to this [article] chapter or as may be appropriated, from time to time, by the council shall be deposited into the highway beautification and disposal of abandoned or derelict vehicles revolving fund [which is] established by [chapter 3.25] section 3.25.030 of the Maui County Code.”

SECTION 5. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
