WHEREAS, Section 8-2.3 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter") provides that the Corporation Counsel shall be the chief legal advisor and legal representative of the County, the Council, the Mayor, all departments, all boards and commissions, and all officers and employees in matters relating to their official duties; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-2.2 of the Charter currently permits the removal of the Corporation Counsel only if initiated by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, as the chief legal advisor of both the Council and the Mayor, the Council and the Mayor should be equally authorized to determine whether their respective interests are being adequately represented by the Corporation Counsel, and to remove initiate removal of the Corporation Counsel at their discretion; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That, pursuant to Section 14-1(1) of the Charter, it hereby proposes that Section 8-2.2 of the Charter, pertaining to the Corporation Counsel, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 8-2.2. Corporation Counsel. The corporation counsel shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the council and may be removed by the mayor with the approval of the council [.], or by resolution approved by a two-thirds vote of the entire membership of the council with the approval of the mayor. The corporation counsel shall be an attorney licensed to practice and in good standing before the Supreme Court of the State and shall have engaged in the practice of law for at least three years."; and

- 43. That, pursuant to Section 14-2(1) of the Charter, this resolution be submitted to the voters of the County of Maui at the next general election; and
- That the County Clerk prepare the necessary ballot for presentation to the voters at the next general election; and
- Let 5. That, pursuant to Section 14-1(1) of the Charter, it hereby proposes that the following question be placed on the next general election ballot:

"Shall the Charter be amended to allow the Council or the Mayor, independently, to initiate removal of the County's chief legal advisor and representative, the Corporation Counsel?"; and

- That, pursuant to Section 14-2(2) of the Charter, the County Clerk publish this proposed amendment in a newspaper of general circulation; and
- That, upon approval by the majority of the voters voting on the proposed amendment and upon official certification of such result, the amendment proposed herein shall take effect; and
- \mathcal{G} That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and the Corporation Counsel.

Prosecuting Attorney.** The prosecuting attorney shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the council and may be removed by the mayor with the approval of the council[.], or by resolution approved by a two-thirds vote of the entire membership of the council. The prosecuting attorney shall be an attorney licensed to practice and in good standing before the Supreme Court of the State and shall have engaged in the practice of law for at least three years."; and
