

**SUBJECT: REDESIGN OF THE SOUTH MAUI GYMNASIUM IN KIHEI
TO A MULTI-PURPOSE CENTER (EAR-16)**

In May 2014, based on the recommendations of the Budget and Finance Committee, the Council referred to the Economic Development, Energy, Agriculture, and Recreation Committee the matter relating to redesign of the South Maui Gymnasium. The intention of the Budget and Finance Committee was to evaluate the feasibility of expanding the project scope to create a multi-purpose facility capable of hosting conferences, tournaments, and other events that can generate economic activity.

At the Committee's meeting of October 28, 2014, the Interim Director of Parks and Recreation informed the Committee that the Department was exploring a redesign of a community center that is more of a multi-purpose facility with recreational components, indoor-outdoor court space, workout centers, fitness areas, and different types of rooms that can be rented out or used for recreational purposes.

May I please ask that you provide an update and summary of the design status?
