Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on August 2, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-146, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE 1. AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES: DEPARTMENT OF **ENVIRONMENTAL** MANAGEMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM - SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FUND, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE COSTS; OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS: TOTAL AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by: 1) increasing estimated revenues for Charges for Current Services by \$148,585; 2) increasing estimated revenues for Interfund Transfers by \$400,000; 3) increasing estimated revenues for Carryover/Savings in the General Fund by \$400,000; 4) amending Section 3.B.3.f., Department of Environmental Management, by increasing the Environmental Protection and Sustainability Program – Solid Waste Management Fund, by \$548,585 under Category B – Operations, and adjusting the total accordingly; and 5) amending Section 3.B.4.f., Department of Finance, by increasing Countywide Costs, Supplemental Transfer to the Solid Waste Management Fund, by \$400,000 under Category B – Operations, and adjusting the total accordingly.

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2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX B, REVENUES – FEES, RATES, ASSESSMENTS AND TAXES, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FUND, CHARGES FOR CURRENT SERVICES, FEES – REFUSE DISPOSAL."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix B of the FY 2017 Budget, by adjusting fees charged by the Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Management Fund, Charges for Current Services, Fees – Refuse Disposal.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for FY 2017, dated July 7, 2016, for \$400,000 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.

Your Committee notes through consultation with the Department during the Budget session, the Council estimated a cost for the Department's waste-processing contractual services for FY 2017. Your Committee urged the Department to contain cost increases for contractual services and obtain better terms for the County.

The Director of Environmental Management said his Department has renegotiated the fees of the EKO Systems, Inc., dba Maui EKO Systems, contract related to biosolids from \$90 to \$103 per ton and uncontaminated greenwaste from \$25 to \$36 per ton.

He further said since Maui EKO Systems is the only vendor with grease trap waste or contaminated cooking oil, the Department was able to negotiate a cost reduction for those disposal services from \$60 to \$37 per ton.

The proposed changes to the fees will result in additional estimated revenue of \$148,585 for this fiscal year.

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A representative from the Office of the Mayor said the proposed change to Appendix B relating to the Interim Fee Schedule is a result of the Municipal Solid Waste fee increase from \$80 to \$81 per ton. The Interim Fee Schedule is based on a fee per truckload of waste and is applicable at County landfills where there are no scales or when the scales are inoperable.

In addition to appropriation of the additional revenue from fees, the Director is also requesting a supplemental transfer from the General Fund to the Solid Waste Fund of \$400,000. He said the funding is needed to offset a projected shortfall in Category B funding for operational expenses.

Your Committee was concerned with the termination of the household battery and paint programs. Through these programs, residents were able to dispose of these items at designated drop-off sites throughout the County. Your Committee urged the Department to reinstate the program for FY 2017.

A representative from the Department said the household battery and paint programs were previously funded through a grant from the State. She said grants received by the County for recycling have decreased in FY 2017, and therefore, the Environmental Protection and Sustainability Division evaluated the various recycling programs offered by the County. The County will continue with the electronics and used motor oil programs as well as annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events, accepting items such as batteries, paint, and other household waste material. The next event is scheduled for August 2017.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Couch, Crivello, and Guzman voted "aye." Committee member Victorino was excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2017 Budget.
