SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION FOR EXPENDITURE OF FORFEITURE FUNDS

The Police Department has forfeiture funds available from the Federal Equitable Sharing Forfeiture Program. These funds were obtained through the Department's enforcement efforts and must be used only for law enforcement purposes and not to supplant the law enforcement resources of the local agency.

We are informing you of our intent to use \$149,005.42 in Federal Forfeiture Funds to pay for a Leica ScanStation P16 Package for use at crime scenes. The 360-degree laser scanning system will be used to document crime scenes and produce 3-dimensional computer generated replication of crime scene details for presentations during court testimony.
