Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on September 1, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-183, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, COUNTYWIDE, COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget to add the Improvements to the Wailuku Police Station Records and Evidence Room project to the list of Capital Improvement Projects in Appendix C, for the Department of Police, Countywide Police Facilities.

Your Committee notes the proposal is to add to the list of approved projects and does not include a funding request. The Budget Director said the proposed amendment does not require an increase to funds already appropriated in FY 2017 for Countywide Police Facilities. The proposed amendment to Appendix C is to add the project and allow the Department to expend appropriated funds.

A representative from the Department stated the project began in FY 2015 with Phase I, the installation of bulletproof windows and walls in the Records Section of the Wailuku Station. Phase II of the project will be completed during FY 2017 and will include bulletproofing the Evidence Section. He confirmed the addition of this project will not impact the other listed projects because the cost for one of the existing projects is lower than expected.

The representative said the Department processes 500 to 700 firearms permits each month. The representative explained the firearms

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brought into the Wailuku Station for processing should not contain ammunition. However, he noted there are occasions where the firearms may be loaded. The improvements to the facility will increase safety for employees and the public.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Baisa, Carroll, Couch, Crivello, and Guzman voted "aye." Committee members Cochran and Victorino were excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

- 1. That Bill _____ (2016), attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, COUNTYWIDE, COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT; and
- 2. That County Communication 16-183 be FILED.
