Committee Report No. 16-139

Honorable Chair and Members of the County Council County of Maui Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii

Chair and Members:

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee, having met on August 23, 2016 and August 29, 2016, makes reference to the following:

1. County Communication 16-148, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to delete, from the list of streets where parking is prohibited in the Wailuku District, Pili Street, located between Market Street and Church Street. The deletion is being proposed because Pili Street has been consolidated into the Wailuku Municipal Parking Lot parcel.

2. County Communication 16-150, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit parking at all times on the south side of Nahono Place, from Lower Honoapiilani Road, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii, as prohibited by signs. The prohibition is being proposed to improve safety on the street.

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Your Committee noted the Public Works Commission unanimously recommended approval of the proposed bills at its meeting of April 27, 2016.

At its meeting of August 23, 2016, your Committee considered the Pili Street matter. The Director of Public Works said updates to the Maui County Code are necessary after title issues concerning road remnants, such as Pili Street, were resolved and incorporated into the Wailuku Municipal Parking Lot parcel.

The Director said ingress and egress to the lot is currently marked with signs indicating the lot is used for parking. He said street signs depicting the street as Pili Street were never installed.

Your Committee agreed once the parking lot is established, the designation of Pili Street will not be necessary. Therefore, deletion of the street as referenced in Section 10.48.040, Maui County Code, is appropriate.

Your Committee notes the historical and cultural significance of Market Street. After the expansion of the sugar industry in the 1860s, Wailuku Town, particularly Market Street and the immediate surrounding areas, became a commercial hub of mom-and-pop shops, banks, and other businesses that served the needs of the growing community.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions.

Your Committee voted 4-0 to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Cochran, Vice-Chair Hokama, and members Baisa and Guzman voted "aye." Committee members Carroll, Crivello, and White were excused.

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At its meeting of August 29, 2016, your Committee considered the Nahono Place matter. The Director of Public Works said safety concerns arose when cars parked on the south side of Nahono Place forced motorists turning onto the street to enter the outgoing left turn lane onto Lower Honoapiilani Road. He confirmed signage would be installed to mark the proposed no-parking zone along the south side of Nahono Place. The Director said the Department of Fire and Public Safety and Department of Police have no concerns with the proposed parking prohibition or location of the signs.

Your Committee stressed the importance of enforcing parking laws in the Traffic Code, particularly those governing overnight parking and parking that obstructs sight lines preventing vehicle and pedestrian safety. Your Committee noted Section 10.48.030, Maui County Code, sets guidelines for the parking of a vehicle next to driveways and next to stop signs. Furthermore, Section 10.48.110, Maui County Code, prohibits overnight parking longer than sixty minutes between the hours of two a.m. and six a.m. on any day.

Your Committee voted 5-1 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Cochran and members Baisa, Carroll, Crivello, and Guzman voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair Hokama voted "no." Committee member White was excused.

Your Committee agreed the proposed amendments for Pili Street, Wailuku, and Nahono Place, Lahaina, should be consolidated into one bill as both amend parking prohibitions as noted in Section 10.48.040, Maui County Code.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON PILI STREET, WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII, AND NAHONO PLACE, LAHAINA,

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MAUI, HAWAII," incorporating your Committee's recommended revisions and nonsubstantive revisions.

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

- 1. That Bill \_\_\_\_\_\_ (2016), as revised herein and attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON PILI STREET, WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII, AND NAHONO PLACE, LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT;
- 2. That County Communication 16-148 be FILED; and
- 3. That County Communication 16-150 be FILED.

#### A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON PILI STREET, WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII, AND NAHONO PLACE, LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 10.48.040, Maui County Code, is amended to read

as follows:

**"10.48.040 Parking prohibited on certain streets and highways.** No operator of any motor vehicle shall park the same or permit such vehicle to be parked on the following portions of the public streets and highways of the County:

A. Wailuku [District.] district.

[1. On both sides of Pili Street in Wailuku, between Market Street and Church Street;

2.] <u>1.</u> On the south side of Wells Street [in Wailuku], between the corner of Wells <u>Street</u> and High [Streets] <u>Street</u> and the concrete sidewalk running from Wells Street to the front entrance of the [Court House;] <u>court house</u>.

[3.] <u>2.</u> On the north side of Vineyard Street from a point eighty-six and one-half feet west of North Church Street to North High Street[;].

[4.] <u>3.</u> On the north side of Vineyard Street, between Central Avenue and Market Street [in Wailuku;].

[5.] <u>4.</u> On the east side of South Market Street, between Wells Street and Pakahi Street[;].

[6.] <u>5.</u> On both sides of West Main Street from thirty feet west of and sixty feet east of <u>the</u> culvert located one hundred fifty yards east of <u>the</u> intersection of West Main Street and Ilina Street[;].

[7.] <u>6.</u> On the east side of North Market Street from Kapoai Place to <u>the</u> driveway leading to Liko Place[;].

[8.] 7. On both sides of Kinipopo Street[;].

[9.] <u>8.</u> On the north side of Wells Street [in Wailuku] from the intersection of High Street and Wells Street to Kinipopo Street[;].

[10.] <u>9.</u> On the west side of Central Avenue from

East Main <u>Street</u> and Kaahumanu Avenue [from East Main and Kaahumanu Avenue] to a point opposite Maluhia Drive[;].

[11.] <u>10.</u> On the east side of North High Street from West Main <u>Street</u> to Vineyard Street[;].

[12.] <u>11.</u> On both sides of the paved portion of Kinipopo Street[;].

[13.] <u>12.</u> On the south side of Aupuni Street from South High Street to Awapuhi [Street;] <u>Place.</u>

[14.] <u>13.</u> On the north side of Lower Main Street from the intersection of Mill Street to Kaniela Street[;].

[15.] <u>14.</u> On the west side of Kinipopo Street [in Wailuku] from the intersection of Wells Street to the intersection of Oihana Street[;].

[16.] <u>15.</u> On the south side of West Main Street [in Wailuku] from the intersection of Ilina Street to five hundred feet west of the intersection of High Street[;].

[17.] <u>16.</u> On the south side of Mokuhau [Place in Wailuku] <u>Road</u> from the end of the road at the turnaround area for a distance of [.3] <u>three-tenths of a</u> mile east of the point[;].

[18.] <u>17.</u> On the west side of North Church Street [in Wailuku] from [Waikane] <u>Waikahe</u> Place to the intersection of Vineyard Street[;].

[19.] <u>18.</u> On the west side of Hinano Street [in Wailuku] from the intersection of Olu Drive to the intersection of Vineyard Street[;].

[20.] <u>19.</u> On the west side of North Market Street [in Wailuku], starting from a point one hundred feet north of Kahawai Street for a distance of one hundred seventy feet north from that point[;].

[21.] <u>20.</u> On the west side of Central Avenue from the intersection of Mill Street to East Main Street[;].

[22.] <u>21.</u> On the south side of Mill Street, between [Poles No.] <u>pole numbers</u> 6 and 7 of Maui Electric [Co., Ltd.;] <u>Company.</u>

[23.] <u>22.</u> On the south side of Pakahi Street [in Wailuku] from South Church Street to South Market Street[;].

[24.] <u>23.</u> On the south side of Palua Street [in Wailuku] from South Church Street to South Market Street[;].

[25.] <u>24.</u> On the south side of Kaohu Street [in Wailuku] from High Street for a distance of ninety-six feet[;].

[26.] <u>25.</u> On the east side of Kalawi [Street,] <u>Place</u>, beginning one hundred twenty-eight feet south from the intersection of Kaohu Street for a distance of eighty feet around a sharp curve[;].

[27.] <u>26.</u> On the makai side of Koeli Street [in

Wailuku], beginning thirty feet from the intersection with Malako Street for a distance of three hundred seventy-three feet; provided, that such prohibited parking shall be applicable only on school days, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and between 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.[;]

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[28.] <u>27.</u> On the north side of Kaohu Street from its intersection with Kalawi Place and South Market Street to the Kalana O Maui parking lot[;].

[29.] <u>28.</u> On the south side of Kaohu Street from Kalawi Place to Kiele Street on school days only, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m., except on Wednesdays when such hours shall be between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m.[;]

[30.] <u>29.</u> On the [mauka (west)] <u>west</u> side of Kalua Road from [the prolongation of] Kaohu Street to a point eightyfive feet south of the intersection[;].

[31.] <u>30.</u> On the west side of Mission Street[,] for a distance of ninety-one feet [in the southerly direction] <u>south</u> from the intersection of Mission Street and Mill Street[;].

[32.] <u>31.</u> On both sides of Lono Avenue from its intersection with Kaahumanu Avenue to its intersection with Kamehameha Avenue[;].

[33.] <u>32.</u> On the west side of Puunene Avenue, beginning at the junction of Puunene Avenue and Mokulele Highway and extending to a point approximately one hundred forty feet south of the intersection[<u>;</u>].

[34.] <u>33.</u> On the west side of Awapuhi Place [in Wailuku;].

[35.] <u>34.</u> On both sides of Ainahou Place[;].

[36.] <u>35.</u> On the south side of Wells Street, within twenty feet on either side of the driveway to Wells Park tennis court parking lot[;].

[37.] <u>36.</u> On the south side of Wells Street, within seventy feet from the west edge of South Market Street[;].

[38.] <u>37.</u> On both sides of South Market Street, between Wells Street and Pakahi Street[;].

[39.] <u>38.</u> On the north side of Main Street [in Wailuku], beginning at Puahau [Lane] <u>Place</u> and extending west for a distance of eighty feet[;].

[40.] <u>39.</u> On the north side of Main Street [in Wailuku], beginning at Puahau [Lane] <u>Place</u> and extending east for a distance of eighty feet[;].

[41.] <u>40.</u> On both sides of Kaikoo Street, beginning at its intersection with Waiehu Beach Road and extending for a distance of one hundred ten feet[;].

[42.] <u>41.</u> On both sides of North Street, between Central Avenue and Hinano Street[;].

[43.] <u>42.</u> On the east side of Lunalilo Street, beginning at its intersection with Kaahumanu Avenue to a distance of one hundred feet north of the northern property line of the parcel of land identified [by] for real property tax purposes as tax map key number (2) 3-8-007:057[;].

[44.] <u>43.</u> On both sides of Onaona Street[;].

[45.] <u>44.</u> On both sides of Wailani Street, between East Vineyard Street and Nani Street[;].

[46.] <u>45</u>. On the south side of Kahawai Street, between Market Street and Makua Street, as prohibited by signs.

B. Lahaina [District.] district.

1. On the east side of Front Street, between Dickenson Street and Prison [Road at Lahaina;] <u>Street.</u>

2. On the south side of Lahainaluna [Street going toward Lahainaluna High School] <u>Road</u>, between Collins Park and the Pioneer Mill Company's Clubhouse [at Lahaina;].

3. On both sides of the entire roadway within the Lahaina Civic Center Complex from its intersection with Honoapiilani Highway[;].

4. On the west side of Luakini Street, between Lahainaluna Road and Prison Street[;].

5. On the south side of Prison Street [in Lahaina] from Luakini Street to Honoapiilani Highway[;].

6. On the east side of Front Street [in Lahaina], between Kapunakea Street and Kahoma Stream or Unahiole Circle[;].

7. On the Kaanapali side of Papelekane Street from Wharf Street to Front Street[;].

8. On both sides of Prison Street from Front Street to Luakini Street[;].

9. On both sides of Dickenson Street from Front Street to Luakini Street[;].

10. On both sides of Front Street from Wong Store to the Lahaina Broiler[;].

11. At the Kaanapali end of Wharf Street at its intersection with Papelekane Street[;].

12. On the Kaanapali side of Lahainaluna [Street] Road from [Laukini] Luakini Street to Honoapiilani Highway[;].

13. On the mauka side of Front Street [in Lahaina], between Wahie Lane and Papalaua Street[;].

14. On both sides of Wahie Lane [in Lahaina;].

15. On the makai side of Front Street for a distance of one hundred twenty-one feet south of the north property line of Whaler's Market Place, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.[;]

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16. On the makai side of Front Street for a distance of one hundred seventeen feet north of the south property line of Whaler's Market Place, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. each day; provided, that any bus certified by the public utilities commission of the State shall be permitted to stop, stand, or park in the loading and unloading zone for the purpose of loading and unloading passengers, and then only for a period not to exceed fifteen minutes[;].

17. On the west side of Wainee Street from the intersection of its centerline of Dickenson Street to a point two hundred sixty feet north of the intersection, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, except public holidays[;].

18. On both sides of [Laukini] <u>Luakini</u> Street, between Hale Street and Dickenson Street[;].

19. On the south side of Lahainaluna Road, between Wainee Street and Honoapiilani Highway[;].

20. Along the west side of Front Street from a point one hundred feet north of the four-foot wide pedestrian access easement located upon the parcel of land identified [by] for real property tax purposes as tax map key number (2) 4-6-002:002, to a point one hundred feet south of the easement[;].

21. On the Kaanapali side of Aholo Street[;].

22. On the Kaanapali side of [Wiliko] <u>Wili Ko</u> Place[;].

23. On both sides of Hinau Street, between Honoapiilani Highway and Limahana Place[;].

24. On the Kaanapali side of Dickenson Street from Honoapiilani Highway to Wainee Street[;].

25. On the mauka side of Wainee Street from Lahainaluna Road to Dickenson Street[;].

26. On the makai side of Wainee Street from Waianae Place to Prison Street[;].

27. On the makai side of Lower Honoapiilani Road from its intersection with Kaanapali Shores [Drive] <u>Place</u> to Honokowai to its intersection with Kapalua Place [in Kapalua;].

28. On both sides of Kapunakea Street, between Front Street and Honoapiilani Highway[;].

29. On the Kaanapali side of Panaewa Place[;].

30. On the Kaanapali side of Panaewa Street[;].

31. On the south side of Puukolii Road, beginning at Kalapu Drive through the end of Puukolii Road[;].

32. On both sides of Kumukahi Street, between Kuialua Street and Niheu Street, applicable only on school days, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and between 1:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.[;]

33. On both sides of Akahele Street, between Honoapiilani Highway and Mahinahina Street[;].

34. On both sides of Front Street from Honoapiilani Highway, north toward Shaw Street, as prohibited by signs.

<u>35.</u> On the south side of Nahono Place, from Lower Honoapiilani Road, as prohibited by signs.

C. Makawao [District.] <u>district.</u>

1. On the north side of Makawao Avenue from the intersection of Makawao Avenue and Baldwin Avenue to a point one hundred fifty feet west of the intersection [at Makawao;].

2. On the west side of Baldwin Avenue, Paia, from the entrance to <u>the old</u> Paia Mill warehouse for a distance of two hundred feet in the direction of Makawao[;].

3. On the mauka side of Hana Highway in Pauwela, between Haiku School Road and West Kuiaha Road**[;]**.

4. On the south side of Makawao [in Makawao] from the intersection of Makawao Avenue and Baldwin Avenue to a point seventy feet west of the intersection applicable only on school days from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., and from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.[;]

5. On the north side of Haliimaile Road for a distance of approximately thirty feet from the Haleakala Junction[;].

6. On both sides of Kilakila Place in Pukalani, within three hundred feet of its intersection with Haleakala Highway[;].

7. On both sides of Kokomo Road, between Haiku Road and Lowrie Ditch[;].

8. On both sides of Ulumau Place.

D. Lanai [District.] district.

1. On the west side of Lanai Avenue, between Sixth <u>Street</u> and Seventh [Streets;] <u>Street</u>.

2. On both sides of Seventh Street, between Koele Street and Lanai Avenue[;].

3. On both sides of Sixth Street, between Lanai Avenue and [Frazer] <u>Fraser</u> Avenue; provided, that such prohibition shall be only during school days during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

E. Hana [District.] <u>district.</u> On Keawa Place [in Hana] fronting Helene Hall, for a distance of one hundred forty-six feet.

F. Molokai [District.] district.

1. On both sides of Ailoa Street in Kaunakakai[,

Molokai,] for a distance of fifty feet on both sides of the crosswalk fronting Kaunakakai <u>Elementary</u> School [cafetorium,] <u>cafeteria</u>; provided, that such prohibition shall be only during school days during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.[;]

2. On both sides of Alohi Street from its intersection with Kamoi Street for a distance of two hundred feet to the east.

G. Kihei [District.] <u>district.</u> [1.] On both sides of Lipoa Street, between Piilani Highway and South Kihei Road."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
