SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Public Works, I am transmitting the attached proposed bills for the purpose of adding a \$185,000 appropriation in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Budget, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, General Fund for a capital improvement project entitled, "2154 Kaohu Street Building Improvements".

The project involves the renovation of real property located at 2154 Kaohu Street that was purchased by the County in FY 2016. The property will be renovated into offices to house various County offices such as the Community Development Block Grant Program, Metropolitan Planning Organization, and other County personnel as needed.

The additional appropriation will be funded by increasing Carryover/Savings General Fund in the amount of \$185,000. Attached for your information is a Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2017 certifying the availability of General Fund Carryover/Savings.

The Department of Public Works is requesting that the proposed bills be considered as soon as possible. I respectfully request that this matter be referred to the appropriate Council committee for expeditious review, discussion and appropriate action.
