Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 4, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-214, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN CONCERNS, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix C of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget to clarify and add to the project descriptions provided for several Capital Improvement Projects.

Your Committee notes a new appendix was created in the FY 2017 Budget containing a project description and funding amount for each Capital Improvement Project for which an appropriation was made. The appendix describes how each project appropriation can be used and breaks down the funding appropriation. Capital Improvement Project funding may not be used for any purpose other than as described in the appendix.

Your Committee further notes the clarifications to the project descriptions include adding design phases and specifying construction and installation of equipment. The proposal includes revised project descriptions for projects of the departments of Environmental Management, Finance, Housing and Human Concerns, Management, Parks and Recreation, Police, and Public Works.

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Your Committee further notes the proposal includes no changes to the appropriated funding amounts.

In response to your Committee's questions on one of the projects, the Budget Director explained the word "Acquisition" was replaced with the word "Equipment" in the description for the Lahaina Refuse Office in the West Maui Community Plan Area because the office trailer is considered equipment. The word "Acquisition" is typically used in the context of real property. Your Committee noted the amended project description would allow for the purchase or lease of the office trailer.

The Budget Director also informed your Committee that various projects may include permitting, site plan fees, Disability and Communications Board Fees, or other fees, which may be incurred at any phase throughout the project.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Baisa, Carroll, Couch, Crivello, Guzman, and Victorino voted "aye." Committee member Cochran was excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

- 1.
