Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on September 1, 2016, September 13, 2016, and October 4, 2016, makes reference to County Communication 16-167, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES: DEPARTMENT MANAGEMENT, OF WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA. GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, WAIKAPU BASEYARDS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS: AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by (1) increasing the Bond/Lapsed Bond Fund by \$550,000; and (2) adding an appropriation of \$550,000 under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, for the Waikapu Baseyards project.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (BOND FUND – WAIKAPU BASEYARDS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2017 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding

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\$550,000 under Public Improvements, Estimated Project Cost, Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for the Waikapu Baseyards project.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WAIKAPU BASEYARDS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding (1) an appropriation of \$550,000 under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, for the Waikapu Baseyards project; and (2) a description of the project.

4. A report entitled "COUNTY OF MAUI, WAIKAPU FACILITIES MASTER PLAN, Final Submission – April 2015," prepared by HDR Engineering, Inc.

Your Committee notes the Waikapu Baseyards Project involves the planning and development of 100 acres acquired by the County for base-yard operations and other County facilities. The existing County base-yard facilities in Central Maui are organized independently and exist as separate departments across various locations. The project will create a single, consolidated base yard to improve operational efficiency and reduce operating costs. Additionally, the Project Master Plan is being amended to include a new base yard for the Department of Transportation.

Before the County can move forward in utilizing the project property, as well as the adjacent 209-acre property purchased for park use, the requested funds are needed to perform an archeological inventory plan and study, an environmental assessment, and lot consolidation and

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resubdivision. This will help identify the appropriate location for the base yards and location for future sports park use.

Your Committee further notes the Project Master Plan reflects the recommendation of the community and Councilmembers to locate the base yard away from the residential area of Waikapu and closer to Kuihelani Highway. This will help minimize the noise and traffic impacts from refuse trucks and other County vehicles on residents living nearby.

Your Committee discussed the location of the new Waikapu Fire Station within the project. The Waikapu Fire Station will improve coverage of the Department of Fire and Public Safety in the Waikapu area as well as provide additional support to brushfire-prone areas nearby.

In response to questions from your Committee, the Budget Director informed your Committee the project does not include the Waiale Road extension cost. The project includes the cost of the interior road from Kuihelani Highway up to Waiale Road. The Budget Director stated the first phase of the project will cost approximately \$50 million.

The Director informed your Committee it is possible that portions of the water and wastewater systems may be financed through the use of State Revolving Fund loans which may have lower interest rates than general obligation bond rates.

Your Committee added a proviso to the bill amending the FY 2017 Budget requiring quarterly status reports on the project be submitted to the Council. This will give Council adequate time to plan for financing future phases of the project.

Your Committee expressed concern about spending \$50 million on Phase I of the project, while the County faces urgent needs in the areas of affordable housing and homeless issues.

Your Committee voted 6-1 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Baisa, Carroll, Crivello, and Victorino voted "aye." Committee

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (WAIKAPU BASEYARDS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$29,753,000] \$30,303,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (the "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the

Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
