Dear Governor Ige:

Pursuant to Chapter 209E, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 6 of Title 15, Hawaii Administrative Rules, we request your approval to designate Molokai as an Enterprise Zone for twenty years. The current Enterprise Zone designation will expire on December 31, 2016.

The Enterprise Zone designation has proven to stimulate economic development and generate employment while providing tax incentives and giving priority in business permit processing to qualified and enrolled businesses.

The County of Maui will offer eligible Molokai businesses in agriculture, manufacturing, wholesaling, and other businesses engaged in Enterprise Zone eligible activities, a three-year exemption from any increase in property taxes resulting from new construction in the enterprise zone.

The designated boundaries, as depicted in Exhibit A, attached hereto, proposed are: Beginning at the eastern point where Kalawao County District boundary meets the ocean, the boundary follows clockwise around the Molokai coastline until it meets the western point where Kalawao County District meets the ocean. The EZ boundary then follows the Kalawao Molokai District boundary until it meets the starting point.

According to the 2010 census, the island of Molokai (Census Tracts 317 and 318.01) qualifies for enterprise zone status under the following conditions, as depicted in Exhibit B, attached hereto: low median income and the high unemployment rate. Molokai has an unemployment rate of 7.9%, which is almost 2 times the State's average unemployment rate of 3.9%, according to Exhibit C, attached hereto.

The Maui County Council is recommending, and I concur, that Molokai is designated as an enterprise zone for a new twenty year term pursuant to Chapter 209E, HRS. The Maui County Council passed a Resolution in support of designating the island of Molokai as an enterprise zone, a copy of which is provided as Exhibit D.



AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO REQUEST THE GOVERNOR OF HAWAII TODESIGNATE THE ISLAND OF MOLOKAI AS AN ENTERPRISE ZONE FOR TWENTY YEARS DUE TO EXPIRATION OF THE PRIOR ENTERPRISE ZONE DESIGNATION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.80.030, MAUI COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii previously designated the Island of Molokai as an enterprise zone pursuant to Chapter 209E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and Chapter 6 of Title 15, Hawaii Administrative Rules, for a twenty-year period; and

WHEREAS, the designated Molokai Enterprise Zone's twenty-year period will expire on December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the criteria for designating the Island of Molokai as an enterprise zone remains applicable and such designation has proven to stimulate economic development on the Island of Molokai and the County of Maui; and

WHEREAS, the County of Maui desires to continue to encourage sound economic development and generate employment by providing tax incentives to approved businesses within such an enterprise zone, as more specifically set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, by having the Island of Molokai again designated as an enterprise zone for another twenty-year period; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.80.030, Maui County Code, provides that nomination for designation as enterprise zone requires approval by the Council of the County of Maui by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the County of Maui will offer eligible Molokai businesses a three-year exemption from any increase in property taxes resulting from new construction in the enterprise zone; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

- 1. That it does hereby authorize the Mayor to submit the application in Exhibit "A" to the State Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism, for processing and recommendation to the Governor for designation of the Island of Molokai as an enterprise zone; and
- 2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and the Director of the Office of Economic Development.
