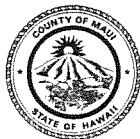

SUBJECT: **HOMELESSNESS IN MAUI COUNTY** (HHT-38)

At its meeting of October 11, 2016, the Housing, Human Services, and Transportation Committee received an update on the homeless population throughout Maui County.

May I please request your Department's response to the following:

1. Provide a list of government and nonprofit agency programs available for the homeless population coping with mental health issues. Identify whether State or Federal funds support the program and amount of funds provided.
2. Explain the need for mental health assessments conducted by service agencies, law enforcement agencies, and medical facilities. Further, explain how the assessments contribute to the services provided to the homeless population.
3. Provide a summary of the State's Housing First program and availability of funds to Maui County, including the amount and purpose of the funds.

May I request that you provide your response no later than **Friday, November 4, 2016**. To ensure efficient processing, please include the relevant Committee item number in the subject line of your response.
