A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,
DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY
(HAWAII CRIMINAL JUSTICE DATA CENTER)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, by adding a new grant entitled, "Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center", in the amount of \$41,000 to read as follows:

"11. Department of the Prosecuting Attorney

f.	Food Stamp Fraud Prosecution Program	3,000

h.	Prosecutors Training Program	50,000

i.	Special Needs Advocacy Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 6.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	1,005,000
j.	Victim/Witness Assistance Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 1.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	90,620
