The funds have been allocated as follows: Kauai County = \$415,833 and Maui County = \$400,000.

The County of Kauai's allocation will be used to improve transit fleet technology and operating efficiencies through implementation of computer-aided dispatch, automatic vehicle location, and other technological components. A utility vehicle will be procured to support off-site bus stop and fleet maintenance. Shop and office equipment acquisitions will be made to improve/maintain current operations. Administrative and maintenance facility repairs will be done to maintain a state of good repair. See Budget section for detailed information concerning each activity.

The County of Maui's allocation will be used to purchase three (3) 8 passenger accessible and one (1) 25 passenger accessible vehicles to replace decommissioned buses. For further information, see the respective budget line items.
