## SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Environmental Management, I am transmitting the attached proposed bill for the purpose of increasing the appropriation for the Solid Waste Operations Program – Solid Waste Management Fund, B – Operations, in the amount of \$30,000. The additional appropriation is needed due to additional hauling costs for cardboard, newspaper, and scrap metal from the Olowalu Convenience Center to the materials recycling facility.

## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, SOLID WASTE OPERATIONS PROGRAM – SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FUND; TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)
