Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 7, 2017, and March 21, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 16-110, from Councilmember Hokama, relating to amendments to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget to authorize transfers between categories of use that are within a program or department.

By correspondence dated February 8, 2017, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET."

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget within the Department of Fire and Public Safety by transferring \$11,455 from the Administration/Maintenance program, Category C (Equipment), to the Training Program, Category C (Equipment), for matching funds required to access a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program – Operations and Safety Program.

The proposed resolution references Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, which restricts disbursements for each program by category of use, with allocations specified for (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay (Category A); (b) operations or services (Category B); and (c) equipment (Category C).

The Fire Chief said the Department of Fire and Public Safety applied for and was awarded a grant of \$527,046 to purchase Self-Contained

Breathing Apparatus units. A 10 percent match, or \$52,704, of non-Federal funds is required to access the grant.

He informed your Committee \$41,250 is allocated in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget to purchase replacement canisters for the Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus units. The Department will combine those funds with the proposed request of \$11,455 for the required matching funds.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS that Resolution \_\_\_\_\_, attached hereto, entitled "AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET," be ADOPTED.

AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 9-10(2) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), provides that, upon written request of the Mayor, part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance may be transferred within a department by resolution or from one department to another by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, ("Fiscal Year 2017 Budget"), states that, unless otherwise provided, appropriations for each program may be disbursed for the following categories of use: (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay, (b) operations or services, and (c) equipment; provided the disbursement is within the program and category of use for which it was appropriated; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B.5. of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, relating to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, sets forth appropriations for the Administration/Maintenance Program and Training Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter, Mayor Alan M. Arakawa has submitted a written request to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$11,455 from the Administration/Maintenance Program,

Category C, to the Training Program, Category C, in order to disburse \$11,455 for fire equipment from the appropriate program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter and Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions, and in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, it does hereby authorize the transfer of an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$11,455 from the Administration/Maintenance Program, Category C, to the Training Program, Category C, for fire equipment; and

2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor,

Director of Finance, Budget Director, and Chief of Fire and Public Safety.
