SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION FOR EXPENDITURE OF FORFEITURE FUNDS

The Police Department has forfeiture funds available from the Federal Equitable Sharing Forfeiture Program. These funds were obtained through the Department's enforcement efforts and must be used only for law enforcement purposes and not to supplant the law enforcement resources of the local agency.

We are informing you of our intent to use \$11,654.91 in Federal Forfeiture Funds to pay for ice machines for our Lanai and Hana stations. The cost includes the two (2) ice machines along with assembly and installation costs.
