SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2018 BUDGET (BD-16) (BF-1)

Pursuant to your letter dated April 6, 2017, I am transmitting responses for the following requests/questions:

1. Explain how inflationary factors relating to sewer, electricity, and water delivery charges are calculated.

Response: The following was provided as a response to BD-14. "Inflationary adjustments were based on the average of FY 2015 and FY 2016 actual usage multiplied by a compounded rate of 0.05 for water, sewer, and electricity and 0.03 for gasoline and diesel fuel (less) the FY 2017 adopted amount. Attached is the inflationary factor schedule that was used to calculate the adjustments which can also be found on page 4 of the program budget under Reader's Guide to the Budget.

Please note that FY 2015 and FY 2016 actuals may differ due to the timing differences between extraction of the report(s) from IFAS and release of the budget instructions to the departments in August.

In addition, if a department did not agree with the calculations reflected in the analysis, a justification was provided to the Budget Director and adjusted appropriately in the FY 2018 proposed budget."

2. How was premium pay budgeted for in FY 2018? Was the actual amount of premium pay expended for FY 2016 and FY 2017 to date, factored into calculating the proposed request for FY 2018?

Response: The amounts included in the FY 2018 budget for premium pay are amounts that were requested by the department. Any expansion requests, were evaluated by the Budget Office and the Administration based on available resources

and need. Because the basis of the budget is the previous year's council adopted numbers, we did not take into consideration FY 2016 actuals and FY2017 year-to-date numbers.

3. Provide the rate schedule, to include golf rounds, green fees, and tournament fees for municipal golf courses throughout the State. Include the number of staff and position titles for each course. Also provide revenues and expenditures for each golf course, including fringe and overhead charges.

Response: Please see the attached spreadsheets for Hawaii Municipal Golf Course Fee Comparison and the Hawaii Municipal Golf Course Revenue and Expenditure Comparisons. The information provided on these spreadsheets is the only information available at this time.
