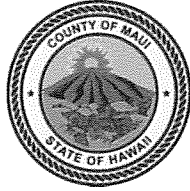



We are in receipt of your letter dated April 10, 2017 in which you requested a response to the following:

“Identify ways the Department of Police would be able to recoup some of the labor costs from the services provided to other departments and outside agencies.”

Response: It is the Department of Finances understanding that the Police emergency dispatch system is essentially a clearing house for community concerns including those of County departments and outside agencies (Federal and State). This system is a great benefit to the community at large. It is unclear if Police has the ability to easily track with whom they interact on a daily basis, and if they did, what the mechanism would be that would allow Police to charge for their emergency dispatch services.
