SUBJECT: REQUESTS/QUESTIONS FROM THE APRIL 5, 2017 MEETING (OM-4) (BF-1)

Thank you for the opportunity to clarify OED's position regarding the Kula Ag Park expansion on A&B lands.

The Kula Ag Park expansion project will be greatly impacted by how much the state appropriation will be for the purchase of the land from A&B.

OED believes the best way to proceed within the scope of the FY 2018 County budget, is to budget \$1,000,000. For the state match which is required in the appropriation bill.

In addition to that, OED is requesting \$50,000. For a First Phase Engineering Study which will deliver a planning level site layout for lots, irrigation pipes, meters, and power infrastructure. It will also provide cost estimates for site work, infrastructure & road development, permitting requirements, and a 20 yr. operational cost analysis and business plan. We would also ask for the plan to include a phased build-out plan in case full funding is not available or there is not enough demand for all the lots.

The \$50K would ONLY be used if a state appropriation for purchase of the land would come through. If there is no state appropriation, then this project would not go forward.

Furthermore, it is the belief of OED that once the First Phase Engineering Study is completed, the county should negotiate with A&B to deliver a **turn-key project** to the county. This should be a much more cost-effective approach for the county.

This strategy should mitigate the county's risk of unknown costs to develop a Kula Ag Park expansion, and allow us to still take advantage of a state appropriation if it comes through.
