A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES;
DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT,
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM;
TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund in the amount of \$85,509; and by increasing Total Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$85,509, to read as follows:

SUBJECT: BUDGET AMENDMENT

During the Fiscal Year 2018 budget deliberation process, a decision was made to eliminate the Countywide CIP Coordinator (MD-0055) from the Department of Management's program. This position played a critical role in providing assistance to departments that lacked the internal expertise to efficiently and effectively navigate the complexities associated with capital improvement projects. Unfortunately, input was not sought regarding this decision and departments were not provided an opportunity to explain how this position has benefited their operations.

Management has attempted to operate without this position but, given the increase in requests over the past month, it has become very apparent how desperately departments require assistance. Over the course of the past month, Management has received numerous requests for CIP assistance from departments including the

Department of Fire and Public Safety, Maui Police Department, Department of Housing and Human Concerns, and the Department of Public Works. These requests have ranged in complexity from minor to major projects.

Due to the repeated reduction of Management's staff over the past two fiscal years, our CIP group has been reduced to one civil engineer (MD-0053) and one project coordinator (MD-0060). We analyzed the workload of these two individuals and it was determined that they are unable to take on additional projects without severely impacting their current projects. It is for this reason that we are requesting that you consider our request for a budget amendment which would amend the Fiscal Year 2018 budget by restoring the Countywide CIP Coordinator (MD-0055) E/P along with funding sufficient to recruit and fill the position for nine (9) months which is estimated at \$83,000.

I humbly request that you consider this request for a budget amendment as expeditiously as possible given the growing need to provide assistance. We believe that this amendment, if supported by the Maui County Council, will allow us to take on additional projects and ultimately better serve the people of Maui County.
