Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on September 12, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-313, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; **DEPARTMENT** OF WATER SUPPLY, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WATER SUPPLY, WAILUKU WATER COMPANY ACQUISITION: TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget by 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund by \$150,000; and 2) adding an appropriation of \$150,000 under the Department of Water Supply, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Water Supply, Water Supply Fund – Unrestricted, for the Wailuku Water Company Acquisition. The funds will be used for an appraisal of property and infrastructure owned by Wailuku Water Company, LLC.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WAILUKU WATER COMPANY ACQUISITION."

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The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding 1) an appropriation of \$150,000 under the Department of Water Supply, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, for the Wailuku Water Company Acquisition; and 2) a description of the project.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2018, dated July 21, 2017, for \$150,000 in Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund.

Your Committee met on February 14, 2017 and June 13, 2017 to consider proposed bills to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget to provide funding for an appraisal of property and infrastructure owned by Wailuku Water Company, LLC.

Your Committee was also in receipt of County Communication 17-37, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WATER SUPPLY, WAILUKU WATER COMPANY ACQUISITION; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund by \$150,000; and 2) adding an appropriation of \$150,000 under the Department of Water Supply, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Water Supply, Water Fund – Unrestricted, for the Wailuku Water Company Acquisition. The funds will be used for an appraisal of

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property and infrastructure owned by Wailuku Water Company, LLC.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, CENTRAL MAUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WAILUKU WATER COMPANY ACQUISITION."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding 1) an appropriation of \$150,000 under the Department of Water Supply, Central Maui Community Plan Area, for the Wailuku Water Company Acquisition; and 2) a description of the project.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2017, dated December 14, 2016, for \$150,000 in Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund.

The Mayor informed your Committee the County is interested in purchasing approximately 8,764 acres of land and the surface water conveyance system owned by Wailuku Water Company, LLC (the "Owner"). The funds, if approved, will be used for an appraisal.

By correspondence dated March 17, 2017, the Chair of your Committee requested the Mayor provide information regarding the business operations, condition of the surface water conveyance system, and other related matters related to the proposed acquisition.

By correspondence dated June 1, 2017, the Mayor provided general responses, indicating a confidentiality agreement between the County and the Owner is needed to obtain the documentation requested by your Committee.

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Your Committee did not receive the necessary documentation and information requested prior to the end of Fiscal Year 2017 on June 30, 2017. Therefore, your Committee took no action on the proposed Fiscal Year 2017 Budget amendments. Your Committee chose not to file the related County Communication 17-37.

Subsequently, your Committee was verbally informed by the Budget Director a confidentiality agreement was executed between the County and the Owner, and documentation was received from the Owner to continue discussion on the matter.

At its meeting of September 12, 2017, your Committee voted to convene an executive meeting, closed to the public, to deliberate concerning the authority of persons designated by the County, the Council, or the Committee to negotiate the acquisition of public property pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes; and to consult with legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of the County, the Council, and the Committee pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Following the executive meeting, your Committee reconvened in regular session.

Your Committee noted a decision by the Council to move forward with an appraisal does not commit the County to acquisition of the property and water system. Your Committee viewed the appraisal as part of the County's due diligence necessary to determine whether the acquisition is in the public's best interest.

Your Committee will maintain the ability to work with the Administration on the scope and parameters of the appraisal.

Your Committee voted 5-0 to recommend passage of the proposed Fiscal Year 2018 bills on first reading and filling of County Communication 17-313. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay,

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Crivello, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Carroll, Cochran, Guzman, and King were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions to the bill identified in item 1 under County Communication 17-313.
