Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 3, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-285, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018, HAWAIIAN CULTURAL RESTORATION REVOLVING FUND."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds, Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, by adding a new revolving fund entitled "Hawaiian Cultural Restoration Revolving Fund (Chapter 3.38, Maui County Code)" and anticipated revenues of \$180,000 for Fiscal Year 2018.

Your Committee notes Ordinance 4393 (2016) established the Hawaiian Cultural Restoration Revolving Fund ("Fund"). The Fund receives all proceeds from the parking concession located on property under the control and management of the County on the area identified as tax map key (2) 4-6-007:036 in Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii. The funds deposited shall be used for the preservation and restoration of Hawaiian historic and cultural sites and artifacts relating to Moku`ula and the ponds of Mokuhinia, including maintenance of the site.

Your Committee noted the Fund was inadvertently omitted from the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget. The proposed bill is to add the Fund to Appendix A, Part II, and to recognize the anticipated revenues. The proposed bill does not include any request for expenditures to be made from the Fund.

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Your Committee also noted the parking lot concession was awarded to Diamond Parking. As a requirement of the request for proposals, an electronic monitoring system was installed to track parking activity.

The Interim Director of Finance said the County has received approximately \$75,000 in revenue since July 1, 2017, which will be deposited into the Fund. He confirmed there has been no expenditure made from the Fund to date.

He also said the agreement for the parking lot contemplates the County receiving 83 percent of the gross parking receipts collected by Diamond Parking, with a minimum of \$15,000 as the base rent. The average revenue to the County has been \$25,000 per month.

The Director of Parks and Recreation noted concerns relating to the maintenance and upkeep of the parking lot, and whether the current lease with the Friends of Moku`ula still requires the organization to maintain the parking lot.

Your Committee anticipates your Parks, Recreation, Energy, and Legal Affairs Committee will further review the contract awarded to Diamond Parking, the role of the Friends of Moku`ula including their existing lease with the County, and other matters relating to Moku`ula and the ponds of Mokuhinia.

By correspondence dated October 2, 2017, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO THE GENERAL BUDGET PROVISIONS." The purpose of the proposed bill is to revise Section 14, General Budget Provisions, to include the Hawaiian Cultural Restoration Revolving Fund as item "T."

Your Committee did not take action on the proposed bill to amend the General Budget Provisions. However, recognizing the amendment to the General Budget Provisions is a housekeeping measure, your

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2018, is hereby amended by adding a new Revolving Fund entitled, "Hawaiian Cultural Restoration Revolving Fund", and anticipated revenues of \$180,000 for Fiscal Year 2018, to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 14, General Budget Provisions, by revising the reference set forth under "A through S" to "A through T", to read as follows:

"SECTION 14. The special purpose revenues set forth in Appendix A, Part II (attached hereto and made a part hereof), are expected to be on hand as of June 30, 2017, or derived by the County during Fiscal Year 2018, from the programs or activities described in the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, the Maui County Code, or the Hawaii Revised Statutes at the references set forth under A through [S] T therein. The balance remaining in each of the special purpose revenue funds as of June 30, 2017, is hereby re-appropriated to the particular fund. Revenues derived from the particular program or activities during the fiscal year shall be deposited into the applicable special purpose revenue fund. Expenditures from a fund shall be through appropriations set forth in Appendix A.II. of the annual budget ordinance."

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
