Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on February 13, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 17-415, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, DRAINAGE, SOUTH MAUI DRAINLINE REPAIRS, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, DRAINAGE, CENTRAL MAUI DRAINLINE REPAIRS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2018 Budget by 1) increasing Estimated Revenues from the Bond Fund by \$4,440,000; 2) amending Section 4.J.3., by adding an appropriation of \$450,000 under the Department of Public Works, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, Drainage, Bond Fund, for the South Maui Drainline Repairs; 3) amending Section 4.J.6.a.(1), by increasing the appropriation by \$3,990,000 under the Department of Public Works, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Drainage, Bond Fund, for the Central Maui Drainline Repairs; and 4) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4454, BILL NO. 63 (2017), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 general obligation bond authorization ordinance for the Department of Public Works by 1) adding an appropriation of \$450,000 for the Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, Drainage, for the South Maui Drainline Repairs; and 2) increasing the appropriation by \$3,990,000 for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Drainage, for the Central Maui Drainline Repairs.

3. The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, for the Department of Public Works, by 1) adding a \$450,000 appropriation and project description for the South Maui Drainline Repairs project for the Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area; and 2) increasing the Central Maui Drainline Repairs project appropriation by \$3,990,000 for the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area.

Your Committee notes the proposed bills transmitted by County Communication 17-415 relate to drainline repairs in Kahului, Waiehu, and South Maui.

At the request of the Chair of your Committee, the Budget Director transmitted revised proposed bills separating the projects by area, with a separate set of proposed bills for Kahului, Waiehu, and South Maui.

With respect to the drainline repairs for South Maui, the Budget Director transmitted the following:

The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding an appropriation of \$450,000 and a project description for the South Maui Drainline Repairs project, under the Department of Public Works, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area.

Your Committee notes it previously reported on this matter through Committee Report 17-177, which recommended that the revised proposed bills relating to the Kahului Drainline Repairs be passed on first reading and be ordered to print. At its meeting of December 1, 2017, recessed to December 4, 2017, the Council adopted the recommendations in Committee Report 17-177 (Ordinances 4791, 4792, and 4793).

Your Committee further notes it previously reported on this matter through Committee Report 17-186, which recommended that the revised proposed bills relating to the Waiehu Drainline Repairs be passed on first reading and be ordered to print. At its meeting of December 15, 2017, the Council adopted the recommendations in Committee Report 17-186 (Ordinances 4798, 4799, and 4800).

The Director of Public Works said approximately 475 feet of drainline is in need of repair beneath Wailea Alanui Drive. The drainline is made of corrugated metal pipe and is reaching the end of its useful life. He said the deterioration has resulted in a sinkhole at its connection with the catch basin on the mauka side of the roadway. He added the repair to the drainline is critical to prevent damage to the water and sewer lines in the same area.

The Director said the drainline crosses two sewer lines and two water lines, making it too difficult to replace the drainage pipe. He said the Department is considering a "cured-in-place" method to rehabilitate the drainline. This method is a trenchless technology to install a liner inside of the existing metal pipe to extend its useful life. Trenchless technology does not require excavation to rehabilitate a drainline; rather,

the liner may be installed by accessing the drainline through a manhole or other existing access point.

The Director explained the pipes need to be in reparable condition to qualify for the "cured-in-place" method. If a pipe is "bottomless" and deformed, it would require replacement instead of rehabilitation. He said salt air, water, and other materials that flush through the pipes have accelerated the corrosion of the metal.

The Director said the proposed project does not qualify for State or Federal funds. He said the Federal-aid project for a portion of Wailea Alanui Drive that was completed in April 2016 included reconstruction of the roadway and curb ramps; repair of the drainline, sidewalk, and curbs and gutters; and installation of signage, pavement striping, and markers. The project was limited to the portion of Wailea Alanui Drive from Okulani Drive to Wailea Ike Drive. He said the drainline repair used the "cured-in-place" method.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the revised proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Committee is in receipt of further revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2018 Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4454, Bill No. 63 (2017), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$49,435,000] <u>\$48,485,000</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (the "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be

provided for in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
