Your Policy, Economic Development, and Agriculture Committee, having met on June 19, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 17-7, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to nominations to boards, committees, and commissions.

By correspondence dated June 4, 2018 (received on June 5, 2018), the Mayor transmitted a proposed resolution, entitled "RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF HANNAH WERTH TO THE COUNCIL ON AGING," along with a completed application for the nominee. The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve or disapprove the Mayor's nomination of Hannah Werth to the Council on Aging, for a term expiring on March 31, 2020, to fill a vacancy due to the resignation of David Spicer.

Your Committee notes general appointment procedures for boards and commissions are outlined in Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and Chapter 2.41, Maui County Code ("MCC").

Your Committee further notes specific provisions for the Council on Aging are located in Sections 2.34.020, 2.34.030, and 2.40.010, MCC.

The Council must approve or disapprove Ms. Werth's nomination to the Council on Aging by August 4, 2018, or the nomination will be deemed approved.
