Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on July 24, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-248, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to Appendix B, Rates and Fees, Department of Parks and Recreation facilities.

By correspondence dated July 2, 2018, Mayor Alan M. Arakawa informed the Council the Department of Parks and Recreation ("Department") is unable to implement the fee changes for use of County facilities and equipment adopted by the County Council for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019 because they encountered a problem updating the software that would require the closing of all permit offices to reprogram the system.

By correspondence dated July 2, 2018, the Mayor transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX B, REVENUES – FEES, RATES, ASSESSMENTS AND TAXES, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, GENERAL FUND, CHARGES FOR CURRENT SERVICES, SCHEDULE OF FEES AND DEPOSITS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 Budget, Appendix B, Revenues – Fees, General Fund, Charges for Current Services, Schedule of Fees and Deposits, by amending the fees for use of park facilities and equipment by 25 percent over FY 2018 fees.

Your Committee notes the fee increases in the FY 2019 Budget addressed the escalation of the costs to provide parks and recreation facility and equipment services. Your Committee was not made aware of the Department's Community Class Program Policies and Procedures Packet & Information ("Policies and Procedures") when the fee increases

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were adopted. A reduction in the amount of fees collected will require the County to make up the revenue difference elsewhere.

Your Committee recommended the Department review its Policies and Procedures to consider whether changes should be made to limitations on class size and fees charged to class students to fairly reflect the increase in parks facility fees.

The last time the Department proposed increasing parks fees was in FY 2017. However, the fee increases were companion revisions to amendments made in the Maui County Code and not a comprehensive fee increase. The Department informed your Committee it holds annual discussions with parks facility instructors, but fee increases have not been discussed for at least the last four years.

The Director of Parks and Recreation said a percentage increase in the Department's fees across the board is much easier to implement than the same twenty-dollar increase for each fee.

Your Committee recommended page 3 of the proposed bill, relating to Community Class Permits, be amended to read as follows:

"Community Class Permit" means lessons, instruction or classes offered to the general public and conducted by an instructor approved by the department. Class participation charges or fees are allowed within the limits established by the department. In accordance with the Community Class Program Policies and Procedures, facility fees are assessed per class. A class shall not exceed two hours. Temporary refreshment concessions are prohibited.

Your Committee also recommended a new Section 3 be inserted into the proposed bill to read, "For the period July 1, 2018 through August 31, 2018, the facility rates pursuant to Ordinance 4456 (2017) shall be in effect." Your Committee revised the existing Section 3 of the proposed bill by renumbering it to Section 4 and replacing the phrase "upon its approval" with "on September 1, 2018." These revisions will allow the Department to charge park facility fees set forth in the FY 2018

Class participation charges or fees are allowed within the limits established by the department. In accordance with the community class program policies and procedures, facility fees are assessed per class. A class shall not exceed two hours. Temporary refreshment [concessions in accordance with section 13.04A.140] are prohibited.

"General Use Permit" means a permit issued under Chapter 13.04A for an event or activity for which dues, registration fees, or

The land provided or dedicated shall have an area of five hundred square feet for each lot or unit, in excess of three, resulting from the subdivision; provided, for residential workforce lots or units within a subdivision, the land area shall be 250 square feet for each lot or unit.

In lieu of providing land in perpetuity or dedicating land, the director of parks and recreation shall require the subdivider to:

- 1. Pay to the County a sum of money equal to the number of square feet that would have been required by Section 18.16.320.B.2.c multiplied by the average of the following values, determined at subdivision approval, in accordance with the most recent certified assessment for real property tax purposes in the respective community plan area where the subdivision is located:
 - The average value per square foot of lands classified as residential. and
 - The average value per square foot of lands classified as apartment.
- 2. Combine the payment of money with land to be provided or dedicated, on the basis of five hundred square feet per each lot or unit, in excess of three, resulting from the subdivision; provided, for residential workforce lots or units within a subdivision, the land area shall be 250 square feet for each lot or unit; or
- Provide improvement to parks and playgrounds in the community plan area where the subdivision is located. The value of such improvements shall be at least equal to the sum of money required to be paid pursuant to this section. The estimate for the cost of the improvements provided shall be based upon cost estimates certified by an engineer licensed to practice in the State of Hawaii. For subdivisions which qualify as affordable housing or residential workforce housing projects, this park assessment fee shall be deferred for either one year from the date of final subdivision approval or until 50% of the dwelling units of the affordable housing project are sold or rented, whichever occurs first.
