Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 2, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-325, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A DONATION OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE WAILUKU HEIGHTS EXTENSION COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION FOR PARK IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WAILUKU HEIGHTS PARK, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE."

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept a donation of \$5,000 from the Wailuku Heights Extension Community Association ("Association") for park playground improvements at the Wailuku Heights Park ("Park").

By correspondence dated September 24, 2018, the Budget Director transmitted the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION (PRIVATE DONATIONS – WAILUKU HEIGHTS EXTENSION COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019, by adding a new appropriation under the Department of Parks and Recreation entitled

“Private Donations – Wailuku Heights Extension Community Association” in the amount of \$5,000.

2. A proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, CENTRAL MAUI PARKS SYSTEM.”

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, for the Department of Parks and Recreation by increasing the appropriation entitled “Central Maui Parks System” by \$5,000.

Your Committee notes the \$30,000 appropriation under Countywide Park Playground Improvements for FY 2017 shall be for park playground improvements at the Park, provided that the Association contributes an additional \$5,000 for improvements to the Park. The Association did not contribute \$5,000 for improvements to the Park in FY 2017.

Your Committee further notes the \$150,000 appropriation under Central Maui Parks System for FY 2019 shall be for park playground improvements at the Park provided that the Association contributes \$5,000 for improvements to the Park.

The Budget Director said the contribution of \$5,000 from the Association has been received. The funds were deposited into a Trust and Agency account until the funds are properly recognized and appropriated for FY 2019.

The Director of Parks and Recreation said the contribution from the Association is recognized as a community outreach project and the Association’s participation in the Park improvements.

He said the playground improvements for the Park did not move forward in FY 2017 because of insufficient County funds for the project. The Director said although the Association did not contribute \$5,000 in FY 2017, it did not affect whether the project would move forward at that time.

Your Committee expressed appreciation for the Association's contribution and its willingness to participate in the project. Your Committee recognized that other projects, such as the Napili Fire Station, were built with community participation and these types of partnerships should be considered when appropriate.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, passage of the proposed bills on first reading, and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Carroll and Cochran were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A DONATION OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) FROM THE WAILUKU HEIGHTS EXTENSION COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION FOR PARK IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WAILUKU HEIGHTS PARK, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE," approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2019 Budget.

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.56, Maui County Code, authorizes the Council to accept gifts and donations on behalf of the County; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:


