Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 2, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-328, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE, OTHER PROJECTS, COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)" ("Budget bill").

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019 Budget by 1) decreasing Bond/Lapsed Bond in the amount of \$145,000; 2) amending Section 4.B.1.a.(1)(i), Department of Finance, Countywide, Other Projects, Bond Fund, Countywide Equipment, by a) decreasing the appropriations for four automated refuse trucks for Central Maui, West Maui, and Makawao by \$150,000 and one roll-off truck for the Central Maui Landfill ("CML") by \$10,000, and b) increasing the appropriation for one wheel-loader for the CML by \$15,000; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT)."

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The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by decreasing the appropriation under the Department of Finance, Countywide, Other Projects, Countywide Equipment by \$145,000, for equipment for the Solid Waste Operations Program.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE, COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT" ("Appendix C bill").

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by revising the appropriations under the Department of Finance, Countywide, Countywide Equipment, for the Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Operations Program, by 1) reducing the appropriations for four automated refuse trucks for Central Maui, West Maui, and Makawao, by \$150,000 and one roll-off truck for the CML by \$10,000; 2) increasing the appropriation for one wheel-loader for the CML by \$15,000; and 3) decreasing the total appropriation by \$145,000.

4. Documents entitled "BID RESULTS COUNTY OF MAUI DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE – PURCHASING DIVISION."

The Deputy Director of Environmental Management said three bid proposals were issued for the equipment for the Solid Waste Division and each proposal received only one bid each. The Budget Director said the bid results for the equipment netted a saving of \$145,000 from the Bond Fund for FY 2019.

Your Committee notes the only bidder for the four automated refuse trucks and one roll-off truck was HT&T Truck Center who submitted a bid

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of \$1,689,735.16 and \$268,914.93 respectively. The sole bidder for the wheel-loader was Hawthorne Pacific for \$514,762.33.

Although your Committee acknowledged the net savings of \$145,000 for the equipment, your Committee expressed concern that the specifications for the equipment may be too specific; therefore, limiting the number of bidders. Your Committee suggested the specifications be more generalized to allow more participation through the competitive bid process.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Carroll and Cochran were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed Budget bill and a revised proposed Appendix C bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2019 Budget.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4858, Bill No. 54 (2018), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follow:

SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$68,660,000] \$68,515,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (the "Fiscal Year 2019 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
