SECTION

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19.04.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "LOT WIDTH"

BILL NO. \_\_\_\_ (2018)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 19.04.040, Maui County Code, is amended by amending the definition of "lot width" to read as follows:

""Lot width" means the [least horizontal distance between lot lines measured through the midpoint of the lot. The midpoint shall be construed to be the midpoint between the opposite lot lines, except for flag lots where the stem shall not be considered.] diameter of the largest circle that can be inscribed within the lot lines."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this ordinance, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
