Dear Land Use Committee -

I respectfully submit this testimony in support of most of the bill <u>bill LU-10</u>. But, the portion that prohibits accessory dwelling use as B&B's or STR's should be removed.

There already is a cap on the number of B&B and STR permits granted. This is the control on short-term rental proliferation. That program, by the way, is the model for other counties in the state.
