Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 16, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-247, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grant Revenue – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019.

By correspondence dated October 5, 2018, the Budget Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs, FY 2019 Budget, for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney ("Department") by adding a new grant entitled "Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program ("Grant")," for \$122,345.

Your Committee notes the Justice Assistance Grant Program is the leading source of Federal justice funding for state and local jurisdictions. The Program supports a broad range of program areas including: law enforcement programs; prosecution and court programs; indigent defense; crime prevention and education programs; corrections and community corrections programs; drug treatment and enforcement programs; planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs; crime victim and witness programs; and mental health and related law enforcement

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corrections programs, including behavioral programs and crisis intervention teams.

The Budget Director said the notice of grant award was received at the end of FY 2018; therefore, the Grant is being recognized in the FY 2019 Budget to give the Department the ability to expend the funds.

A representative from the Department said the funds would be used for training purposes and equipment purchases to assist employees in their daily tasks. He said the Department and the Department of Police alternate receipt of the Grant each year.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee member Cochran was excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS that Bill ______ (2018), attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM)," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4861, Bill No. 57 (2018), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2019 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2019, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, by adding a new appropriation entitled, "Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program", in the amount of \$122,345, to read as follows:

i.	Victim/Witness Assistance Program (1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 1.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	105,728
