A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.08.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO INVESTMENT POLICY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 3.08.040, Maui County Code, is amended by amending subsection A to read as follows: and may adopt

"A. Investment policy.

- The director of finance shall establish a policy on County investments [through the adoption of administrative rules in accordance with chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, or ordinance.
- 2. The investment policy shall establish guidelines regarding the investment of County moneys in excess of the necessary for the meeting of immediate requirements when the action will not impede or hamper the necessary financial operations of the County.
- The policy shall set forth the process for determining when these moneys may be invested.
- The investment policy shall seek to maximize investment income while assuring sufficient cash balances or other immediate forms of daily liquidity are maintained to meet the ongoing obligation of the County.
- The investment policy objectives shall be, in priority order, safety, liquidity, and yield."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the bracketed material.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
