A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE
DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, STATE OF HAWAII
(DO MESTIC VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION GRANT PROJECT)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The Department of the Attorney General, State of Hawaii ("Agency"), through the Crime Prevention and Justice Assistance for the Pomeshic Violence Investigation grant Project,
Division, will provide a maximum amount of \$55,380 to the Maui Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, through Contract Project Number 16-WF-02, as more fully described in Exhibit "1", attached hereto and incorporated herein. The Agency is the designated State Administering Agency for purposes of disbursing federal funds to develop and strengthen effective law enforcement and prosecutorial strategies and victim services in cases involving crimes against women.

This grant award requires that the County provide matching funds in the amount of \$18,460.

Section 2.20.020, Maui County Code, provides that, unless authorized by ordinance, the Mayor shall not enter into any intergovernmental agreement or any amendment thereto which places a financial obligation upon the county or any department or agency thereof.

SECTION 2. <u>Council authorization</u>. Pursuant to Section 2.20.020, Maui County Code, the Council of the County of Maui hereby authorizes the Mayor to
