Fiscal Year 2019 Budget is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 4.B.1.a.(1)(i), Department of Finance, Countywide, Other Projects, Bond Fund, Countywide Equipment, by decreasing the appropriation for two pumper trucks for Kihei and Napili Stations by \$148,000; and adding appropriations for a ladder truck for the Wailea Station, in the amount of \$1,347,000, and one brush truck each for Lahaina and Kahului Stations in the amount of \$152,000, to read as follows:
