SUBJECT: MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE (2019 MAUI COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE) (PEA-4(2))

This is in response to your letter dated October 31, 2018. Your request for a response is as follows:

1. How will zoning and taxation of the land be affected once the land is designated as a cemetery?

Once the land is designated as a cemetery, the taxation of the land is not affected. Currently, burial sites and cemeteries are recognized and treated in the same way for real property taxation purposes.

2. If zoning and taxation is affected, does this happen automatically once the new land designation is in place? If not, what would be the process for the change?

Whether or not there is a change in the designation of the land, taxation will not be affected. Burial sites are given minimal value and are not taxed.
