Honorable Chair and Members of the County Council County of Maui Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii

Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on November 13, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-390, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE, OTHER PROJECTS, COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019 Budget by 1) increasing Estimated Revenues from the Bond Fund by \$1,351,000; 2) amending Section 4.B.1.a.(1)(i), Department of Finance, Countywide, Other Projects, Bond Fund, Countywide Equipment, by a) decreasing the appropriation for the two 1500 Gallons Per Minute ("GPM") pumper trucks for the Kihei and Napili Fire Stations by \$148,000; b) adding an appropriation for a ladder truck for the Wailea Fire Station in the amount of \$1,347,000; and c) adding an appropriation for a portion of two brush trucks, one each for the Lahaina and Kahului Fire Stations in the amount of \$152,000; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by increasing the appropriation under the Department of Finance, Countywide, Other Projects, Countywide Equipment, by \$1,351,000, for equipment for the Department of Fire and Public Safety ("Department"), Fire/Rescue Operations Program.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE, COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by revising the appropriations under the Department of Finance, Countywide, Countywide Equipment, for the Department by 1) increasing the total appropriation by \$1,351,000; 2) appropriating \$1,552,000 for two 1500 GPM Pumper Trucks for the Napili and Kihei Fire Stations; 3) adding an appropriation for one Ladder Truck for the Wailea Fire Station in the amount of \$1,347,000; and 4) adding an appropriation for a portion of two brush trucks, one each for the Lahaina and Kahului Fire Stations in the amount of \$152,000.

4. A copy of the consolidated cost estimate dated October 12, 2018, including discounts for bulk purchasing, for all five trucks submitted by Hughes Fire Equipment.

Your Committee notes for FY 2019, \$1,700,000 from the Bond Fund was appropriated for the acquisition of two 1500 GPM pumper trucks, one each for the Kihei and Napili Fire Stations; and \$300,000 from the General

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Fund was appropriated for two brush trucks, one each for the Lahaina and Kahului Fire Stations.

The Budget Director said in FY 2018, \$1,000,000 from the Bond Fund was appropriated for the acquisition of a ladder truck for the Wailea Fire Station. The Department is requesting the funds be appropriated in the FY 2019 Budget to allow for the consolidation of the acquisition of five vehicles rather than undertaking a separate procurement for each vehicle. This process would allow for discounts to be applied for a bulk sale and cost-savings should be realized.

Your Committee notes the FY 2018 appropriation will lapse on December 31, 2018, and the Department does not have sufficient time to encumber the funds prior to that date.

The Fire Chief said the FY 2018 appropriation was for the replacement of the tower platform truck with a ladder truck for the Wailea Fire Station. He said the ladder truck is more conducive than the tower platform for the operations of the Department.

The Fire Chief said the initial bid proposals received for the ladder truck were more than the FY 2018 appropriation; therefore, the specifications for the truck were revised. He said the revised specifications provide for the safest and efficient vehicle suitable for the Department.

He said following a review of the specifications for the pumper vehicles for the Kihei and Napili Fire Stations, revisions were made to reduce the scope of the specifications. He said the revised specifications do not jeopardize the safety and effectiveness of the vehicles.

The Fire Chief said the two brush trucks requested for Kahului and Lahaina would provide an alternative vehicle for the crews from a specialty vehicle to access certain areas. The Kahului Fire Station has two specialty companies, Rescue and HazMat, and a suppression company. He said whenever a suppression-type fire occurs in the Central area, both specialty companies have limited ability to assist the suppression company because of inadequate pumping capability. The brush trucks would provide the

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specialty crew with an adequate vehicle to respond and assist, especially with off-road incidents. He said the same limitations apply to the Lahaina vehicle, whereas the Lahaina Fire Station has a ladder truck that is not appropriate to respond in off-road incidents.

The Fire Chief said Hughes Fire Equipment provided a cost estimate for the acquisition of five vehicles, including discounts should the five vehicles be purchased under a single procurement. He said the cost estimate provided by Hughes Fire Equipment transmitted to your Committee is not an actual bid for the five vehicles.

Your Committee acknowledged the Department's efforts to explore other alternatives for the procurement and acquisition of large pieces of equipment to maximize the County's purchasing power.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair White and member Guzman were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2019 Budget.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

### A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE – COUNTYWIDE EQUIPMENT)

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4858, Bill No. 54 (2018), is amended by

amending Section 1 to read as follow:

SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$74,849,000] <u>\$76,200,000</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (the "Fiscal Year 2019 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
