URGING THE HAWAII STATE LEGISLATURE TO RAISE THE MINIMUM AGE OF CHILDREN RIDING IN THE BED OF A PICKUP TRUCK FROM THIRTEEN TO EIGHTEEN

WHEREAS, pickup truck beds are designed to carry cargo, not people; and

WHEREAS, because there are no seat belts, truck beds provide no protection during an accident, even at low speeds; and

WHEREAS, in the event of sudden braking, riding in the bed of a pickup truck significantly increases the risk of a passenger being ejected, turning a non-life-threatening accident into a fatal one; and

WHEREAS, internal organ damage, spinal cord injuries, internal bleeding, traumatic brain injuries, amputations, permanent scarring and disfigurement, broken bones, paraplegia and quadriplegia, and severe road rash are among some of the injuries that can be sustained from a truck bed accident; and

WHEREAS, children in covered pickup truck beds are exposed to dangerous carbon monoxide fumes, a toxic chemical that can cause headaches, vertigo, depression, and even death; and

WHEREAS, according to the American Academy of Pediatrics, people who ride in the bed of a truck are three times more likely to be killed than someone riding in the cab; and

WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration reports more than half of truck bed accident fatalities are suffered by children; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it hearby urges the Hawaii State Legislature to raise the minimum age of children riding in the bed of a pickup truck from thirteen to eighteen; and
