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APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT FOR DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, by letter dated January 2, 2019, received by the Council on January 8, 2019, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he appointed Marc Takamori as the Director of Transportation, pursuant to Sections 6-2(5) and 8-14.2 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 6-4 authorized the Council to establish specific qualifications for administrative heads appointed by the Mayor in addition to any set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.14.050, Maui County Code, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," establishes additional qualifications for the Director of Transportation effective January 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 6-2(5) requires the Council to confirm or deny the appointment within sixty days after receiving notice of the appointment by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8-14.2 states: "The director of transportation shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the council"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

- 1. That it deems Marc Takamori to have satisfied the minimum qualifications for the position of Director of Transportation;
- 2. That it hereby approves the appointment of Marc Takamori as the Director of Transportation; and
- 3. That a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor.

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2.14.050 - Director of transportation.

The director of transportation shall have the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. As set forth in the charter, five years of experience in an administrative capacity, either in public service or private business, or both.
- 2. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.
- 3. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of experience in one or more of the following functions:
 - a. Planning and implementation of one or more modes of transportation, including those in the air, water, and land.
 - b. Planning and developing an efficient program to facilitate the rapid, safe, and economical movement of people and goods.
 - c. Coordination of transportation programs by and between private, county, state or federal agencies.
- 4. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, or a combination of education and work experience substantially equivalent to such a bachelor's degree.
