APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT FOR DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION

WHEREAS, by letter dated January 2, 2019, received by the Council on January 8, 2019, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he appointed Karla H. Peters as the Director of Parks and Recreation, pursuant to Sections 6-2(5) and 8-6.2 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 6-4 authorized the Council to establish specific qualifications for administrative heads appointed by the Mayor in addition to any set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.14.040, Maui County Code, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," establishes additional qualifications for the Director of Parks and Recreation effective January 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 6-2(5) requires the Council to confirm or deny the appointment within sixty days after receiving notice of the appointment by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8-6.2 states: "The director of parks and recreation shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the council"; now, therefore,

2.14.040 - Director of parks and recreation.

The director of parks and recreation shall have the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. As set forth in the charter, five years of experience in an administrative capacity, either in public service or private business, or both.
- 2. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.
- 3. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of experience in one or more of the following functions:
 - a. Planning, design, construction, maintenance, or operation of parks and recreational facilities.
 - b. Developing and implementing programs for cultural, recreational, or other leisure activities.
- 4. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, or a combination of education and work experience substantially equivalent to such a bachelor's degree.
